EUREKA, LETS BUCK! – This weekend, the PBR’s elite Unleash The Beast returns to Ontario, California, for the second event of the 24-event 2025 individual season, marking the third time in history the premier series has traveled to Ontario. Toyota Arena will host the PBR for two days of action on Saturday, November 23, at 6:45 p.m. PT and Sunday, November 24, at 11:45 a.m. PT.

CRIMBER CRUISES TO VICTORY – Picking up right where the 2024 PBR Teams MVP left off, John Crimber was the only rider to go a perfect 3-for-3 to take home the first event buckle of the 2025 Unleash The Beast season last weekend in Tucson, Arizona.

In Round 1, Crimber topped Sucker Pop for 89.5 points, putting him second in the event standings heading into Saturday. Now in a groove, the young phenom rode Sometimes I Fly for 87.25 points to punch his ticket into the Championship Round later that afternoon. Trailing only Dalton Kasel in the event standings, Crimber chose Ricky Vaughn as his final animal athlete opponent. The duo roared out of the chutes in Round 3, dancing in perfect time for a monstrous, event-high 92.5 points to catapult Crimber to the top of the event standings. Crimber attempts to remain perfect on the season against Cyrus in Round 1 on Saturday.

Kasel, who had his pick of the pen after riding Dangerous Medicine for 88.75 points in Round 1 and All Hat No Rattle for 89.25 points in Round 2, attempted to retake the lead in the penultimate out of the weekend on Always Been Crazy, who he covered for 92 points in the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas in October. This time, the powerful bovine competitor seized the upper hand after 6.2 seconds to end Kasel’s bid for the title. Kasel takes on Coach in the first round this weekend.

THREE ROUND WINS, THREE 90s – In addition to Crimber’s Championship Round win last Saturday, both Kaiden Loud and Elizmar Jeremias picked up a round win in Tucson courtesy of a 90-point outing.

In the opening round, Loud rocketed out of the chutes on Oyster Creek Brawler for 90.5 points to take the event lead heading into Saturday. Unfortunately for the Texan, he was unable to hang onto Fire Magic, who bested him in 6.24 seconds in Round 2, before bucking off Hell Right in a quick 2.64 seconds in the final round. Loud takes on Flirt Alert in the opening round on Saturday.

Jeremias bounced back to win the second round by riding Constant Payne for 90.25 points, his first career 90-point ride on the premier series, after Crazy Times bucked off the Brazilian in 4.28 seconds in Round 1. After being awarded a re-ride in his first attempt in the Championship Round, Jeremias was unable to solve Feeds Red River in the final out of the weekend, bucking off in 5.54 seconds. Jeremias shares a chute with Cowboy Tuxedo in Round 1 of PBR Ontario.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of PBR Ontario in Ontario, California, will feature just one rematch:

- Lucas Divino looks to remain perfect aboard Joe Hawk, who he topped for 82 points last weekend in Tucson, Arizona.

PAST ONTARIO EVENT WINNERS – The last time the premier series bucked into Ontario, California, in 2010, Austin Meier went a perfect 3-for-3 to win the event title. The Oklahoman started his flawless weekend aboard Wall Street for 86.5 points in Round 1 before punching his ticket to the championship round by covering Bando’s Wild & Wreckless for 81.75 points in Round 2. Meier saved the best for last, surpassing PBR World Champions Chris Shivers and J.B. Mauney in the event standings by riding Braveheart for 88.75 points in the final round to take home the buckle. WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs, and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events. In addition, for each point a rider earns at a lower-level event, a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will be awarded. For example, if a rider earns 100 points by winning a Velocity Tour event, they will earn 25 points in the Unleash The Beast standings, which gives riders a baseline to start from if they make the top tour. A rider will not appear in the Unleash The Beast standings until they have debuted at a 2025 Unleash The Beast event.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut takes place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND’S FORMAT – PBR Ontario, the second Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 40 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Saturday and Round 2 on Sunday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1-2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Sunday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Enterprise Center in St. Louis, Missouri, for PBR St. Louis, presented by Michelob Ultra. The event will be on Saturday, December 7, at 7:45 p.m. CT and Sunday, December 8, at 1:45 p.m. CT.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
