



## **2025 PBR Unleash The Beast**

**THE GATEWAY TO BULLS** – This weekend, the PBR’s elite Unleash The Beast returns to St. Louis, Missouri, for the third event of the 24-event 2025 individual season, marking the 27<sup>th</sup> time in history the premier series has traveled to St. Louis and the third consecutive year. The Enterprise Center will host the PBR for two days of action on Saturday, December 7, at 7:45 p.m. CT, and Sunday, December 8, at 1:45 p.m. CT.

**LEME VICTORIOUS IN ONTARIO, RISES TO NO. 3** – Two-time PBR World Champion Jose Vitor Leme tallied his first victory since winning in Sacramento, California, in February of 2023 by going a perfect 3-for-3 in Ontario, California, two weekends ago.

Bouncing back after a rare shutout in Tucson, Arizona, Leme finished tied for fifth in the opening round after topping I’m Him for 87.5 points. Now having found his groove, the closer for the 2024 PBR Teams Champion Austin Gamblers rocketed out of the chutes on HomeBru for a round-winning 90.25 points, placing him second behind No. 2 Dalton Kasel heading into the Championship Round.

After picking Umm as his final animal athlete opponent, the Brazilian superstar wowed the California crowd by topping the powerful bovine competitor for a monstrous, event-high-tying 90.5 points to catapult to the top of the leaderboard in the penultimate out of the event. Kasel, who held the lead heading into the Championship Round for the second-consecutive event, attempted to respond aboard Reality Check but was unable to make it past 7.16 seconds, finishing the event fourth after going 2-for-3. The Texan won the opening round courtesy of an impressive 90.25-point outing on Coach. Kasel looks to get off to another hot start this weekend aboard Fringe Minority while Leme looks to keep it rolling aboard Windmill in Round 1.

Despite going 0-for-2 in Ontario, No. 1 John Crimber still holds a 32.5-point lead over No. 2 Kasel and a 34.5-point lead over No. 3 Leme. The 2024 PBR Teams MVP looks to return to form atop Mighty Mike in the opening round on Saturday.

**IT’S JUST 8 SECONDS, HOW HARD COULD IT BE?** – While Crimber may have been unable to make the 8 in California, plenty of the best bull riders in the world were in top form in Ontario. The forty riders combined to go an incredible 46-for-90 (51.11%). In addition to Leme, both No. 4 Andrew Alvidrez and No. 6 Lucas Divino went a perfect 3-for-3, finishing second and third, respectively, in the event standings.

Alvidrez began his flawless weekend by hanging onto No Man’s Land for 85.25 points in Round 1. Seeing 22 other riders make the 8 on Saturday, the Texan knew he needed to put together a strong showing to make the podium heading into Sunday. The former powerlifter did just that, topping Good Riddance for 88.75 points in Round 2 before roaring out of the chutes aboard Electric Kitty for 90.5 points in the final round to match Leme for the event-high and split the round victory with the Brazilian. Alvidrez battles Buffalo Heifer in Round 1 on Saturday.

While Divino's numbers were not quite as gaudy, the veteran proved his mettle in Ontario. He finished 23<sup>rd</sup> in the first round after riding Joe Hawk for 72 points but skyrocketed up the leaderboard on Sunday by covering Ah Hell for 85.5 points in Round 2 and Hell Right for 83 points in Round 3. A teammate of Leme on the 2024 PBR Teams Champion Austin Gamblers, Divino takes on Gravedigger in the opening round this weekend.

**FAMILIAR WATERS** – Round 1 of PBR St. Louis will feature six rematches:

- Brady Fielder takes on Mahan for the second time after topping the powerful bovine competitor for 86.75 points in Las Vegas, Nevada, in October.
- Eduardo Aparecido attempts to remain perfect aboard Wild Card after covering the animal athlete for 87.75 points in Albuquerque, New Mexico, in March and for 88.5 points in Billings, Montana, in April.
- Leonardo Castro shares a chute with Slingin' It for the third time after riding him for 84 points in Louisville, Kentucky, in April and being bucked off in 3.33 seconds in Las Vegas, Nevada, in October.
- Mauricio Gulla Moreira dances with Chupacabra once again after sitting tall aboard the rank bovine for 89 points in Fort Worth, Texas, in May.
- Paulo Eduardo Rossetto tries to convert for the first time aboard Simon after the animal athlete bucked off the Brazilian in 3.51 seconds in Indianapolis, Indiana, in March and 2.78 seconds the following weekend in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
- Sandro Batista duels Rockville for the first time since making the 8 for 89 points in Las Vegas, Nevada, in October of 2023.

**PAST ST. LOUIS EVENT WINNERS** – When the PBR bucks in the shadow of the Arch, the world's best tend to rise to the occasion, as 15 of 26 of the PBR's past events in St. Louis have been won by World Champions. Last year continued this trend but added a wrinkle, as Cassio Dias went a perfect 3-for-3 to win his first of seven events en route to his gold buckle in 2024.

In 2023, 2016 PBR World Champion Cooper Davis wowed the crowd with an immaculate 3-for-3 performance, capped by a monstrous, event-high, 91.75-point masterpiece on legendary animal athlete Woopaa in the championship round to secure his first event win of the 2023 season. Before Davis's victory, Daylon Swearingen took home the buckle, and two-time PBR World Champion Jose Vitor Leme was victorious in 2020, winning the event en route to his first title just like Dias. A complete list of past World Champion event winners in St. Louis includes three-time PBR World Champion Adriano Moraes (1997, 1998, 2004), two-time PBR World Champion Chris Shivers (2000, 2001), two-time PBR World Champion Justin McBride (2003, 2005), 2010 PBR World Champion Renato Nunes (2008), 2008 PBR World Champion Guilherme Marchi (2011) and 2018 PBR World Champion Kaique Pacheco (2015, 2017).

**WORLD CHAMPION BULL** – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

**2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS** – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events. In addition, for each point a rider earns at a lower-level event, a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will be awarded. For example, if a rider earns 100 points by winning a Velocity Tour event, they will earn 25 points in the Unleash The Beast standings, which gives riders a baseline to start from if they make the top tour. A rider will not appear in the Unleash The Beast standings until they have debuted at a 2025 Unleash The Beast event.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut takes place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

**THIS WEEKEND’S FORMAT** – PBR St. Louis, the third Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 45 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Saturday and Round 2 on Sunday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1-2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Sunday.

**NEXT UP** – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to INTRUST Bank Arena in Wichita, Kansas, for PBR Wichita. The event will be on Friday, December 13, at 7:45 p.m. CT, and Saturday, December 14, at 7:45 p.m. CT.

**PROVIDING PROTECTION** – This weekend’s bull fighters are Nathan Harp of Tuttle, Oklahoma; Lucas Teodoro of Pinhal, Brazil; and Cody Webster of Wayne, Oklahoma.

**VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS** – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
