BIG TOMATO BUCKOFF – This weekend, PBR’s elite 2025 Unleash The Beast returns to Sacramento, California. The eleventh stop of the 24-event 2025 individual season is the 22nd time in history the PBR has bucked into Sacramento. Golden 1 Center will host the PBR for three days of action on Friday, January 31, at 7:45 p.m. PST, Saturday, February 1, at 6:45 p.m. PST and Sunday, February 2, at 1:45 p.m. PST.

AUSSIE AWESOME ON THE ALLEGHENY, TAKES OVER NO. 1 – Australian Brady Fielder went 3-for-3 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, last weekend to win his second event of the season and overtake No. 2 John Crimber for the No. 1 spot in the Unleash The Beast standings, making him the first cowboy other than Crimber to hold a lead in the 2025 gold buckle race.

Fielder topped Money Moves for 86.5 points in Round 1 before covering Chuck for 85 points in Round 2. Sporting an eight-out ride streak heading into the championship round, Fielder chose UTZ BesTex Smokestack as his final animal athlete opponent. The Aussie cowboy completed his flawless weekend with a bang, scoring an event-high 90.75 points to catapult into the lead.

In addition to winning the event and propelling him to the No. 1 spot in the Unleash The Beast standings, the ride also extended Fielder’s streak to nine and won him his third round of the season, tying him with No. 9 Keyshawn Whitehorse and No. 15 Jose Vitor Leme for the second-most round wins of the season. Currently, Crimber and No. 4 Dalton Kasel hold the lead with four round wins each. While Crimber and Leme are both sidelined due to injury, Fielder attempts to keep his ride streak alive against Vindicated in Round 1 on Friday, while Whitehorse takes on Triple Aught and Kasel shares a chute with T-Wrecks.

Fielder is now 17-for-23 on the season, a tour-best 73.9%. In the 2024 PBR Teams season he had the highest percentage for qualified rides going 24-for-34 (70.59%) to win the Great 8 Award.

The only other rider to go 3-for-3 in Pittsburgh was No. 34 Felipe Furlan, who finished second. After riding Wild Fire for 84.25 points in Round 1 and Sly for 87.25 points in Round 2, Furlan sat tall atop Lights Out for 90.25 points in the championship round, his first career 90-point ride on the elite Unleash The Beast. His out came immediately following Fielder’s 90-point ride. Furlan tries to keep his momentum rolling aboard JB in the opening round in Sacramento.

MONSTER ENERGY TEAM CHALLENGE – This weekend features the fifth game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Missouri Thunder face off against the Kansas City Outlaws.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of Wrangler Long Live Cowboys PBR Sacramento, presented by Cooper Tires, features eight rematches:

- Andrew Alvidrez takes on Sneaky Situation looking to repeat his 89-point outing in Tucson, Arizona, in November of 2023.
- Bob Mitchell faces off with Regulator for the first time since he was bucked off in Los Angeles, California, in 2.19 seconds in February of 2024.
- Cort McFadden shares a chute with Little Tex once again after he made the 8 for 87.25 points in Anaheim, California, last September.
- Dawson Gleaves attempts to cover Umm for the first time after bucking off in 3.23 seconds in Laredo, Texas, in January of 2024.
- Dener Barbosa battles American Hustle for a second time after the Brazilian was bested in 2.76 seconds in Sacramento, California, in August of 2021.
- Julio Cesar Marques tries to ride Rooster's Melt Down for the first time after the pair failed to get out of the chutes in Albany, New York, last December.
- Koltin Hevalow runs it back against July, who bucked off the Missourian in 7.7 seconds in Las Vegas, Nevada, in November of 2022.
- Paulo Eduardo Rosseto was bucked off in 5.2 seconds the first time he was matched with Blown Away in Fort Worth, Texas, in May of 2024.

PAST SACRAMENTO EVENT WINNERS – In 2024, Leonardo Castro went 4-for-4 to take home his first career UTB event title. The Brazilian cowboy topped Pookie Holler for 87 points in Round 1 before hanging onto First String for 58 points in Round 2. Now on a roll, Castro topped Blackstone for 86.5 points in Round 3 and then capped his perfect weekend by riding HomeBru for 87 points in the championship round. Castro was the only rider to cover all four of his bulls, and propelled from No. 47 to No. 10 in the 2024 Unleash The Beast standings.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying eight Bull of the Event titles with only two other bovine competitors holding more than one (No. 2 Fast Flow, who has three, and No. 6 Ridin' Salty, who has two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 5 bull scores in the standings after being marked 48.25 points for his buckoff of Clay Guiton in 3.10 seconds in St. Louis, Missouri, in December. After being marked 47.25 points for his buck off of Brady Fielder in New York City, the powerful bovine competitor retook the No. 1 spot in the standings, and he currently leads No. 2 Fast Flow by a considerable 1.94 points.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS *REVISED* – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will **NO LONGER** be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders took the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND’S FORMAT – Wrangler Long Live Cowboys PBR Sacramento, presented by Cooper Tires, the eleventh Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature four rounds of bull riding. Each of the 43 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and all but those listed below are guaranteed to get on another bull in Round 2 on Saturday and Round 3 on Sunday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1, 2, and 3 will then advance to the championship round following Round 3 on Sunday.

The following three riders from the Missouri Thunder and Kansas City Outlaws must ride on Friday in order to compete for the remainder of the weekend. Those three riders are: Dawson Gleaves (MO), Eric Henrique Domingos (KC) and Miguel de Jesus (KC).

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to the Delta Center in Salt Lake City, Utah, for PBR Salt Lake City. The event will be on Friday, February 7, at 6:45 p.m. MT, and Saturday, February 8, at 6:45 p.m. MT.

The end of Round 1 of PBR Salt Lake City will also feature the sixth game of the Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Oklahoma Wildcatters take on the Arizona Ridge Riders.

PROVIDING PROTECTION – This weekend’s bull fighters are Austin Ashley of Purcell, Oklahoma; Lucas Teodoro of Pinhal, Brazil; and Cody Webster of Wayne, Oklahoma.
