

2025 PBR Unleash The Beast Wrangler PBR Greater Palm Springs Acrisure Arena – Palm Desert, California Friday, March 21 at 7:45 p.m. PT Saturday, March 22 at 6:45 p.m. PT Sunday, March 23 at 1:45 p.m. PT

PALM SPRINGS BUCKOFF – This weekend, PBR's elite 2025 Unleash The Beast heads to Palm Desert, California. The eighteenth stop of the 24-event 2025 individual season is the first time the top tour has bucked into Acrisure Arena. The Golden State will host the PBR for three days of action on Friday, March 21, at 7:45 p.m. PT, Saturday, March 22, at 6:45 p.m. PT and Sunday, March 23, at 1:45 p.m. PT.

KASEL WINS SECOND-STRAIGHT IN LOUISVILLE – No. 2 Dalton Kasel extended his ride streak to six by going 3-for-3 for the second consecutive weekend to take home the event title in Louisville, Kentucky. His second-straight win on the top tour began with the Texan riding El Chapo for 89.5 points to win the opening round. In complete control, Kasel covered Bangarang for 89 points to win the second round and completed the sweep by riding UTZ BesTex Smokestack for a round-high-tying 90.25 points in the championship round. Fresh off re-signing with the Austin Gamblers of the separate PBR Camping World Team Series, his tour-best third victory of the season closed the gap on No. 1 Brady Fielder to 88 points entering Palm Desert, California, where Kasel faces off with Black Harbor in Round 1.

While Fielder wasn't able to outduel Kasel, he extended his ride streak to a tour-best 12 by putting together his fourth-consecutive 3-for-3 weekend. The Australian made the 8 aboard Bull Light for 84.25 points in Round 1 before riding Short Fire for 88.25 points in Round 2. After being awarded a re-ride, Fielder cashed in during the championship round, sitting tall atop Mike's Motive for 90.25 points to tie Kasel for the round win. Fielder's 12-out ride streak has pushed his riding percentage to a league-best 72.1% (31-for-43) and tied him with Jose Vitor Leme (2021), J.B. Mauney (2009) and Justin McBride (2001) for the seventh-longest premier series ride streak in PBR history, 12 short of Silvano Alves's 24-out ride streak spanning from October 2014 to January 2015. Fielder looks to extend his historic streak atop Slick Rick in the opening round on Friday.

No. 12 Paulo Eduardo Rossetto and Rookie of the Year frontrunner No. 14 Anderson de Oliveira were also a perfect 3-for-3 in Kentucky, splitting the final spot on the podium. Rossetto topped Prince Charming for 85 points in Round 1 and Bandito Bug for 86 points in Round 2. The ambidextrous rider finished his weekend by riding Eyes On Me for 89.5 points in the championship round to catapult up the event standings. Oliveira matched Rossetto by making the 8 aboard Down to Fly for 84.25 points in Round 1 before riding Snap Chatter for 87.25 points in the second round. Sharing a chute with Always Been Crazy in the championship round, Oliveira sat tall once again, this time for 89 points, to tie Rossetto for third. Oliveira now holds a 94.83-point lead over No. 21 Elizmar Jeremias in the Rookie of the Year race before dancing with UB Smooth in Round 1 on Friday. Rossetto is paired with Midnight City during the first round in Palm Desert.

Also of note was No. 10 Cort McFadden, who continued his stellar campaign in Louisville by going 3-for-3 and finishing fifth. Tasked with Noslaw Extrasauce in Round 1, the Texan converted for 85.75 points. In Round 2, McFadden rode Sonny B for 84.75 points before covering Preachers Kid for a career-high-tying 90 points in the championship round, his first 90-point ride on the elite Unleash The Beast tour. He faces off with In My Blood in the final out of Round 1.

MONSTER ENERGY TEAM CHALLENGE – This weekend features the eleventh game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Arizona Ridge Riders take on the Oklahoma Wildcatters.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of Wrangler PBR Greater Palm Springs features the following rematches:

- John Crimber battles Cold Creek for the second time after riding him for 87.5 points in Cheyenne, Wyoming, in July of 2024.
- Lucas Divino takes on Big Chew once again after covering him for 88.5 points in Las Vegas, Nevada, in October of 2024.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying eleven Bull of the Event titles with only two other bovine competitors holding more than one (No. 2 Fast Flow, who has three, and No. 5 Ridin' Salty, who has two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 5 bull scores in the standings after being marked 48.25 points for his buckoff of Clay Guiton in 3.10 seconds in St. Louis, Missouri, in December. After being marked 47.25 points for his buck off of Brady Fielder in New York City, the powerful bovine competitor retook the No. 1 spot in the standings, and he currently leads No. 2 Fast Flow by a considerable 1.94 points.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS *REVISED* – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash

The Beast following the tour's first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will *NO LONGER* be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders took the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – Wrangler PBR Greater Palm Springs, the eighteenth Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature four rounds of bull riding. Each of the 42 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday

and all but those listed below are guaranteed to get on another bull in Round 2 on Saturday and Round 3 on Sunday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1, 2 and 3 will then advance to the championship round following Round 3 on Sunday.

The following riders from the Arizona Ridge Riders and Oklahoma Wildcatters must ride on Friday to compete for the remainder of the weekend. Those riders are Everton Natan da Silva (AZ), Dustin Herman (OK), Guilherme Valleiras (OK), Hagen Braswell (OK) and Kase Hitt (OK).

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to The Pit for the PBR Albuquerque Ty Murray Invitational. The event will be on Friday, March 28, at 7:45 p.m. MT, Saturday, March 29, at 6:45 p.m. MT and Sunday, March 30, at 1:45 p.m. MT.

The end of Round 1 in Albuquerque will also feature the twelfth game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Texas Rattlers take on the Austin Gamblers.

The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.

[#]Denotes highest bull score in PBR history

- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
