CBS GAME OF THE WEEK SPOTLIGHT: Nashville Stampede (9-12) @ Carolina Cowboys (15-4-1)

This weekend, on Sunday, September 22, at 3 p.m. EDT, CBS Television Network will broadcast all the action from the *Game of the Week* between the No. 6 Nashville Stampede (9-12) and the No. 1 Carolina Cowboys (15-4-1). In Anaheim, California, last weekend, the Stampede snapped a seven-game loss streak and went a perfect 2-0 to climb right back into the thick of the playoff race as the 2024 PBR Teams season enters the final stretch. The team has been led by three-time PBR World Champion Silvano Alves, who has gone an impressive 9-for-19 (47.4%) on the season entering Cowboy Days this weekend.

On the other side, the hometown Carolina Cowboys have had the most consistent lineup in the league, as Cooper Davis, Derek Kolbaba, Daylon Swearingen and Sage Steele Kimzey are the only quartet to compete in at least 20 games for one team. While the team got off to a scorching start by winning their first six games and not dropping a match until over a month into the season, the Cowboys have shown scratches in the armor over the past few weekends and finished 1-1 in Anaheim. However, the Cowboys have also beaten the Stampede in both previous matchups this season, trouncing them 263.25-0 in Nashville, Tennessee, in August before edging them out, 175.75-86.75, in Kansas City, Missouri, two weeks ago.

RECORD-SETTING WEEKEND IN CALIFORNIA: The best bull riders in the world were in rare form last weekend inside Honda Center, posting an incredible 62 rides across 132 outs (46.97%), the most qualified rides at a single event in PBR Teams history. Three different teams posted at least four rides in a single game, as the Texas Rattlers, Oklahoma Wildcatters and Kansas City Outlaws all had stellar performances throughout the weekend. After a bye on Friday, the Outlaws were in top form in both of their games last weekend, riding four in a 344.25-263 victory over the Arizona Ridge Riders on Saturday and covering four more in a 345.75-263.75 win over the Texas Rattlers on Sunday. Adding in a Shootout Round-winning ride by Sandro Batista following their victory Saturday evening, the Outlaws went an incredible 9-for-12 (75%) in the Golden State. The record-setting weekend brought the league riding percentage up to an impressive 38% heading into the final three weeks of the regular season.

HEAD COACH JEROME DAVIS: One of the PBR co-founders, Jerome Davis was the 1995 PRCA World Bull Riding Champion, becoming the first man east of the Mississippi to win a bull riding world championship. He competed with the PRCA and PBR until 1998, when he was tragically paralyzed from the chest down after being thrown from a bull and breaking his neck. Head Coach J.W. Hart: J.W. Hart, known as "the Ironman," is a former rider and PBR Ring of Honor inductee. He won the World Finals Event in 2002 and was the Rookie of the Year in 1995. Hart was given his nickname after competing in a record 197 consecutive PBR events (a record since broken by Missouri Thunder Co-Head Coach and Assistant General Manager Luke Snyder) from 1994-2003. Hart earned more than \$1.3 million during his career and worked on the PBR broadcast team before joining the Kansas City Outlaws. Hart also boasted previous coaching experience, having worked alongside Nashville's Head Coach Justin McBride during several iterations of the PBR Global Cup USA, leading the Team USA Eagles. With his wife LeAnn, he owns Hart Cattle Company, breeding and training bulls to compete in the PBR.

Assistant Coach Guilherme Marchi: Guilherme Marchi transitions into his new role with the Kansas City Outlaws with his name firmly etched into the PBR record books, inducted into the prestigious Ring of Honor in 2019. No rider in PBR history has stayed on more bulls than Marchi – the all-time ride leader with 635 qualified elite series rides. A beloved figure among fans around the world, the determined rider with the warm smile retired from U.S. competition after the 2018 PBR World Finals, where he had competed 15 consecutive times from 2004-2018. During his 15-year career, Marchi won 25 premier series events, including the PBR World Finals in 2005. He came heartbreakingly close to becoming a multi-time World Champion, finishing runner-up in the world standings four times (2005-2007, 2012). His accomplishments and approachability have helped PBR move into the mainstream. In 2016, Men's Fitness named him "the fittest athlete in sports," putting him on the magazine's cover. No stranger to the role of coach, Marchi led Team Brazil at the 2020 Global Cup USA.

Co-Head Coach Luke Synder: Luke Snyder, PBR Ring of Honor and 2014 Missouri Sports Hall of Fame inductee, watched the film 8 Seconds as a 10-year-old and knew he'd be a bull rider. Snyder emulated Lane Frost on and off the dirt. In PBR competition, he lays claim to perhaps the most impressive record in any professional sport – competing in 275 consecutive events. During nine years of not missing an elite-level event, Snyder battled through a torn rotator cuff, broken right hand, groin pull, broken fibula and broken neck (the latter coinciding with a break in the schedule, allowing him sufficient time to recover). In addition to winning the PBR World Finals in 2001, the year he also won Rookie of the Year, Snyder won six premier series events, including the 2011 Last Cowboy Standing. He qualified for the World Finals 13 times and is No. 25 on PBR's all-time list of earners.

Co-Head Coach Ross Coleman: Ross Coleman rode his first calf when he was 7, won the College National Finals Rodeo allaround title in 1998, and made the PBR Finals in 1999, the first year he went pro, as well as every year thereafter until he retired, ending his 13-year professional career. A native of Molalla, Oregon, Coleman is a member of PBR's exclusive "400 Club" with 438 qualified rides, including 45 for 90 points or more. He won eight PBR premier series events and earned \$1.4 million during his career. In 2012, he was inducted into the PBR Ring of Honor, the most prestigious honor for any bull rider. Coleman has coaching experience in the PBR Global Cup, leading Team USA Eagles to victory at the five-nation tournament in March 2022. He has also run a bull riding school in his home state of Oregon.

Head Coach Kody Lostroh:

Kody Lostroh was named the Head Coach of the New York Mavericks after serving as an Assistant Coach for the Oklahoma Freedom during the league's first seasons. Ten-time PBR World Finals Qualifier Lostroh reached the pinnacle of the sport in 2009 when he was crowned World Champion following a feverish battle with J.B. Mauney. After stepping away from the PBR following the 2014 season, Lostroh was diagnosed with a tumor around his carotid artery in 2015. While Lostroh made a full recovery and briefly returned to competition, he officially retired in March 2018 and has since resided in Colorado with his wife and children. In 2023 Lostroh received the most prestigious honor a bull rider can receive, inducted into the PBR Ring of Honor.

Assistant Coach Ednei Caminhas:

2002 PBR World Champion Ednei Caminhas rounds out the New York Mavericks staff as Assistant Coach, becoming the first rider who competed in PBR Teams to become a coach within the league. Caminhas rode for the Texas Rattlers in 2022 after an individual career of more than two decades with the PBR. The Brazilian began his career with nine consecutive World Finals appearances from 2000 to 2009. A decade after winning the coveted gold buckle, in 2022, he qualified for his 10th career World Finals, becoming the oldest rider ever to compete at the event at the age of 46.

Head Coach J.B. Mauney:

J.B. Mauney, who won the PBR World Championship in 2013 and 2015, logged 538 qualified premier series rides in his career, second all-time in PBR, including 75 90-point rides, before he hung up his bull rope and transitioned to being a coach. In 2009, he became the first rider to record a qualified ride on all eight of his bulls at the PBR World Finals. Known as "The Dragon Slayer" for consistently choosing the most difficult bulls, the North Carolina cowboy famously ended Bushwacker's record streak of 42 consecutive buck offs in Tulsa, Oklahoma, in 2013. Mauney is the highest-earning Western sports athlete in history. His career earnings in PBR totaled \$7,419,474.90.
