

# 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast PBR Wichita

### INTRUST Bank Arena – Wichita, Kansas Friday, December 13, at 7:45 p.m. CT Saturday, December 14, at 7:45 p.m. CT

**CAN BULLS FLY?** – This weekend, the PBR's elite Unleash The Beast heads to Wichita, Kansas, for the fourth event of the 24-event 2025 individual season, marking the third time in history the premier series has traveled to Wichita and the first time since 2011 the top tour has visited the Air Capital of the World. INTRUST Bank Arena will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, December 13, at 7:45 p.m. CT, and Saturday, December 14, at 7:45 p.m. CT.

**CRIMBER CRUISES TO SECOND WIN, BOLSTERS HOLD ON NO. 1** – 19-year-old John Crimber went a perfect 3-for-3, including two 90-point rides, to take home his second event buckle in just three events last weekend in St. Louis, Missouri. Bouncing back from a rare shutout in Ontario, California, the previous weekend, Crimber finished fourth in the opening round after covering Mighty Mike for 89.25 points.

Now in a groove, the 2024 PBR Teams MVP for the Florida Freedom on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series roared out of the chutes on Whiskey Trip for 91.25 points to win the round and take the lead heading into the championship round. With his pick of the pen, Crimber chose UTZ BesTex Smokestack as his final animal athlete opponent. After steadying himself, the young phenom gave the nod and stormed out of the gate, sitting tall for an incredible, round-winning, event-high, walk-off 91.5-point performance. His monstrous final ride was his third 90-point ride of the young season, the most by any rider on the elite Unleash The Beast tour, and his event win netted him 154 Unleash The Beast points. With the victory, Crimber now holds a 132-point lead over No. 2 Dalton Kasel heading into competition this weekend. Crimber takes on Sometimes I Fly, whom he rode for 87.25 points in Tucson, Arizona, last month, in Round 1 on Friday.

**READY TO RIDE** – The best bull riders in the world once again made it look relatively easy taking on the best bulls in the world as they covered 38% of their animal athlete opponents in St. Louis, Missouri, barely missing the 40% mark for the first time this season. Not a single time in 2024 did riders post three-consecutive 35% or better outings, and riders combined for a 40% or better ride percentage only four times total during the entire 2024 Unleash The Beast regular season.

While No. 1 Crimber seized the event win with a perfect weekend, Julio Cesar Marques also put together a flawless 3-for-3 performance in St. Louis. After finishing sixth in the Challenger Global standings, Marques was primed for a breakout season on the premier series, and he has delivered. The Brazilian topped Smoke City for 85.5 points in the opening round last Saturday and then rode Ghost Face for 87.5 points in Round 2. Knowing he needed another solid performance to find the podium, Marques delivered, making the 8 for 89.25 points atop Bueno in the championship round to catapult up to second in the event standings. His silver finish netted him 91.5 Unleash The Beast points, pushing him to No. 6 in the standings. He takes on Walk Hard in Round 1 on Friday.

Also of note was Daniel Keeping, who made his 2025 Unleash The Beast debut last weekend in St. Louis. The Texan rode Big X for an impressive 88 points in Round 1 and Wooderson for 86.75 points in Round 2. Selecting Baldy as his final animal athlete opponent, Keeping rocketed out of the chutes and appeared as if he was going to put together a perfect performance, but was bucked off after a heartbreaking 7.76 seconds. His 2-for-3 performance netted him the final spot on

the podium, garnering the cowboy 60.5 Unleash The Beast points and putting him at No. 11 in the standings. He looks to continue his strong start to the season aboard Sauced Up in the opening round in Wichita.

#### **FAMILIAR WATERS** – Round 1 of PBR Wichita will feature six rematches:

- Dustin Martinez battles Air Marshall for the second time after bucking off in 3.18 seconds in Ocean City, Maryland, in June of 2023.
- John Crimber attempts to cover Sometimes I Fly once again after riding the animal athlete for 87.25 points in Tucson, Arizona, in November.
- Jose Vitor Leme seeks revenge against Lil' Loco, who bucked off the two-time PBR World Champion in 6.04 seconds in Sacramento, California, in January of 2022.
- Kaiden Loud shares a chute with Brown Bomber for the first time since topping the animal athlete for 86.25 points in Tacoma, Washington, earlier this year in April.
- Lucas Divino tries to remain hot aboard Cracker Jack, whom the Brazilian rode for 84 points in their first matchup in Fort Worth, Texas, in May.
- Paulo Eduardo Rossetto runs it back against Bo Man who bucked him off in 3.99 seconds in Billings, Montana, in April.

**PAST WICHITA EVENT WINNERS** – When the PBR's top tour last bucked into Wichita, Ryan Dirteater went an incredible 4-for-4 to hold off Luke Snyder and win the event title. Dirteater began his perfect weekend aboard Frosty for 86.75 points, tying him for the opening round win. In Round 2, the Oklahoman rode Jack Daniel's After Party for a monstrous 90.25 points to take the solo lead heading into the final two rounds. After placing fourth in the third round by covering Clam Digger for 87.25 points, Dirteater put an exclamation point on his flawless weekend by topping Crosswired for an event-high, round-winning 91.75 points in his final out to take home the event title.

Right on his spurs until the dirt settled, Snyder began his weekend a perfect 3-for-3, riding Fully Loaded for 85.75 points in Round 1 and Billionaire for 88.25 points in Round 2. After topping Slim Chance for 86.5 points in the penultimate round, the Missourian was matched up with the legendary Bushwacker for his fourth out. In a 2015 Ring of Honor versus 2016 Brand of Honor recipient showdown, the elite animal athlete got the better of Snyder, bucking him off in a thunderous 2.90 seconds. **WORLD CHAMPION BULL** – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying six Bull of the Event titles with no other bovine competitor holding more than one. The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 5 bull scores in the standings after being marked 48.25 points for his buckoff of Clay Guiton in 3.10 seconds last weekend in St. Louis, Missouri. While he sits No. 3 in the standings, .47 points ahead of No. 4 Fast Flow, the two animal athlete opponents

ahead of him have only one of the eight outs required to qualify, while Man Hater has seven qualified outs. Younts Brody's Pet holds the No. 1 spot after being marked 46.5 points for his buckoff of Alan de Souza in Tucson in his sole premier series out, while Nobody sits in second after being marked 46.25 points for his lone buckoff of Dalton Kasel last weekend in St. Louis.

**2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS \*REVISED\*** – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will **NO LONGER** be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut takes place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

**THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT** – PBR Wichita, the fourth Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 43 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1-2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

**NEXT UP** – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to SNHU Arena in Manchester, New Hampshire, for PBR Manchester. The event will be on Friday, December 20, at 7:45 p.m. ET, and Saturday, December 21, at 7:45 p.m. ET.

**VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS** – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.
