ROCKIN' IN LITTLE ROCK – This weekend, PBR's elite 2025 Unleash The Beast returns to North Little Rock, Arkansas. The sixteenth stop of the 24-event 2025 individual season is the twelfth time and tenth consecutive season the top tour has bucked into Simmons Bank Arena. Arkansas will host the PBR for two days of action on Saturday, March 8, at 7:45 p.m. CT, and Sunday, March 9, at 1:45 p.m. CT.

SAGE STEELE KIMZEY SUPERB IN MILWAUKEE – Sage Steele Kimzey went 3-for-3 to win his first event of the season in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, last weekend, rising from No. 5 to No. 2 in the Unleash The Beast standings. Kimzey rode Skippy for 89 points in the opening round before covering I Hate You for 88 points to win Round 2. Holding the lead heading into the championship round, the Oklahoma cowboy topped Eyes On Me for 88.25 points for a dramatic walk-off victory. Kimzey's first victory of the season made him the twelfth different cowboy to win an event title this season and brought him within 127.25 points of No. 1 Brady Fielder. Kimzey looks to continue his climb up the standings on That'll Play in Round 1 on Saturday.

Fielder maintained his spot atop the standings for the sixth consecutive week by also going 3-for-3 inside Fiserv Forum. The Aussie rode Easy Labor for 86 points in Round 1, Bugatti for 85.25 points in Round 2 and UTZ BesTex Smokestack for 89.75 points in the championship round to finish fourth. Fielder attempts to strengthen his hold on the No. 1 spot in the 2025 gold buckle race by riding Bittersweet in the opening round in North Little Rock, Arkansas.

In second place was Andrew Alvidrez, whose perfect weekend was highlighted by a career-high and tour-season-high 94 points on Man Hater in the championship round last Sunday. The flawless weekend propelled the former powerlifter from No. 10 to No. 6 in the Unleash The Beast standings, 279.75 points behind Fielder. The captain of the Missouri Thunder on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series, Alvidrez takes on Interstate Daydream in the penultimate out of Round 1 as the Thunder take on the Kansas City Outlaws in the Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, matchup in Little Rock.

Also of note were the perfect performances from No. 25 Felipe Furlan, who finished third, and No. 23 Kaiden Loud, who finished fifth. Together, the best bull riders in the world combined to cover 42 of their 91 animal athlete opponents (46.15%), pushing the Unleash The Beast ride percentage to a staggering 40.77% heading into Little Rock this weekend. Furlan attempts to keep it rolling aboard Pixie in Round 1, while Loud takes on Sorrel's Pick.

MONSTER ENERGY TEAM CHALLENGE – This weekend features the ninth game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Missouri Thunder face off against the Kansas City Outlaws.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of PBR Little Rock features the following rematches:

- Claudio Montanha Jr. battles Hunter for the second time after bucking off in 3.71 seconds in Fort Worth, Texas, in May of 2023.
- Grayson Cole faces off with Crazy Times once again after he was bucked off in 3.97 seconds in Glendale, Arizona, in October of 2024.
- Joao Ricardo Vieira shares a chute with Rowdy for the first time since he made the 8 for 84.5 points in Kansas City, Missouri, in September of 2024.
- Keyshawn Whitehorse attempts to ride Casper for the first time after bucking off in all three previous matchups. The Utahn was unseated after 3.1 seconds in Arlington, Texas, in March of 2022, in 4 seconds in Cheyenne, Wyoming, in July of 2022 and in 4.61 seconds in Fort Worth, Texas, in May of 2023.
- Koltin Hevalow takes on Hang ‘em High for a second time after he was bucked off in 3.79 seconds in Fort Worth, Texas, in October of 2023.
- Luciano De Castro seeks his revenge aboard Norse God after he was dislodged in 3.30 seconds in Los Angeles, California, in February of 2024.

PAST LITTLE ROCK EVENT WINNERS – Cassio Dias emerged victorious when the PBR bucked into Little Rock, Arkansas, last season, going 3-for-3 to win his fifth event of the season. The eventual 2024 PBR World Champion flew out of the gate on T-Wrecks for a modest 83 points in Round 1. Dias then locked in, winning Round 2 by covering Tulsa Time for 89.25 points before covering Dark Thoughts for an event-high 90.5 points, his premier-series-leading sixth 90-point ride, in the championship round.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying nine Bull of the Event titles with only two other bovine competitors holding more than one (No. 2 Fast Flow, who has three, and No. 5 Ridin' Salty, who has two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 5 bull scores in the standings after being marked 48.25 points for his buckoff of Clay Guiton in 3.10 seconds in St. Louis, Missouri, in December. After being marked 47.25 points for his buck off of Brady Fielder in New York City, the powerful bovine competitor retook the No. 1 spot in the standings, and he currently leads No. 2 Fast Flow by a considerable 1.94 points.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS *REVISED* – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will **NO LONGER** be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders took the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND’S FORMAT – PBR Little Rock, the sixteenth Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 42 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Saturday and all but those listed below are guaranteed to get on another bull in Round 2 on Sunday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Sunday.

The following four riders from the Missouri Thunder and Kansas City Outlaws must ride on Saturday to compete for the remainder of the weekend. Those riders are: Casey Roberts (MO), Carlos Andre de Oliveira (KC), Grayson Cole (KC) and Maikon Calixton Rocha (KC).

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to the KFC YUM! Center for Kubota PBR Louisville. The event will be on Friday, March 14, at 7:45 p.m. CT, and Saturday, March 15, at 6:45 p.m. CT.

The end of Round 1 in Louisville will also feature the tenth game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Carolina Cowboys battle the Nashville Stampede.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
