

### 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast Kubota PBR Louisville KFC Yum! Center – Louisville, Kentucky Friday, March 14 at 7:45 p.m. ET Saturday, March 15 at 6:45 p.m. ET

**DERBY CITY CHUTE OUT** – This weekend, PBR's elite 2025 Unleash The Beast returns to Louisville, Kentucky. The seventeenth stop of the 24-event 2025 individual season is the seventh time and third consecutive season the top tour has bucked into the KFC Yum! Center. Kentucky will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, March 14, at 7:45 p.m. ET, and Saturday, March 15, at 6:45 p.m. ET.

**DALTON KASEL DAZZLES IN LITTLE ROCK** – Dalton Kasel went 3-for-3 to win his second event of the 2025 season in Little Rock, Arkansas, last weekend to climb back to No. 2 in the Unleash The Beast standings. The Texan rode Feeds Red River for a round-winning 87.75 points in Round 1 before covering Walk Hard for 89.5 points in Round 2. Holding the lead heading into the championship round for the fifth time this season, Kasel took advantage of a re-ride opportunity to cover Feeds Red River once again, this time for 89 points. Kasel now leads the field with eight premier series round wins this year and he is one of just four riders with more than one event win (alongside No. 1 Brady Fielder, No. 4 John Crimber and No. 8 Lucas Divino). Kasel had been 0-for-8 in 2025 championship rounds before converting in the short go in Little Rock. He takes on El Chapo in Round 1 on Friday.

Sitting 149 points ahead of Kasel in the Unleash The Beast standings, Fielder extended his ride streak to nine after going 3-for-3 for the third-consecutive weekend in Arkansas. Fielder rode Bittersweet for 83.75 points in Round 1 and Dark Thoughts for 88.5 points in Round 2. The Australian cowboy pushed his riding percentage to an incredible 70% by making the 8 aboard Eyes On Me for 89 points in the championship round to finish third in the event standings. Fielder tries to become the first rider since No. 33 Daniel Keeping last September to reach 10-consecutive premier series rides on Bull Light in the opening round.

As a whole, the best bull riders in the world continue to make it look easy against their animal athlete counterparts, as they have covered 40.96% of their bulls this season. A total of thirteen riders (minimum 10 premier series outs) have ridden 50% or better on the top tour this season, a mark only four riders hit to finish the 2024 regular season, and only one rider in the Top 25 has below a 40% ride percentage (No. 20 Elizmar Jeremias, who is 14-for-38, 36.8%). The average score it takes to win a UTB round this season is 89.91 points and there have been 12 different Unleash The Beast event winners this year.

One of those thirteen riders converting the majority of the time is No. 6 Keyshawn Whitehorse (21-for-39, 53.8%) who was also 3-for-3 and finished second in Little Rock. After riding Casper for 86 points in Round 1 and Peanut for 86.5 points in Round 2, Whitehorse topped Nobody for an event-high, round-winning 91.5 points in the championship round. It was the Utahn's sixth round win of the season, putting him second in round wins behind only Kasel. Whitehorse faces off with The Undertaker in Round 1 in Louisville.

**MONSTER ENERGY TEAM CHALLENGE** – This weekend features the tenth game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Carolina Cowboys face off against the Nashville Stampede.

### **FAMILIAR WATERS** – Round 1 of Kubota PBR Louisville features the following rematches:

- Adriano Salgado shares a chute with Bayou Bad Boy for the second time after bucking off in 3.56 seconds in Greensboro, North Carolina, in September of 2023.
- Grayson Cole takes on Sandman seeking revenge after bucking off in 6.56 seconds in Shipshewana, Indiana, in November of 2024.
- Joao Ricardo Vieira battles Gunsmoke once again after riding him for 87 points in Greensboro, North Carolina, in September of 2024.
- Keyshawn Whitehorse dances with The Undertaker for the first time since bucking off in 4.52 seconds in Arlington, Texas, in February of 2020.

**PAST LOUISVILLE EVENT WINNERS** – Last year in Louisville, Cassio Dias capped his remarkable regular season by going 2-for-3 to win inside KFC Yum! Center. Tasked with Let's Roll in Round 1, Dias made the 8 for 86.75 points. Despite bucking off Smooth Steel in 3.79 seconds in Round 2, the resilient Brazilian bounced back to top Do Dat Eddie for 88.75 points in the championship round. The win represented Dias's seventh event win of the season and extended his lead in the Unleash The Beast standings heading into the 2024 PBR World Finals. The rookie would eventually go on to be crowned the 2024 PBR World Champion.

**WORLD CHAMPION BULL** – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying ten Bull of the Event titles with only two other bovine competitors holding more than one (No. 2 Fast Flow, who has three, and No. 5 Ridin' Salty, who has two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 5 bull scores in the standings after being marked 48.25 points for his buckoff of Clay Guiton in 3.10 seconds in St. Louis, Missouri, in December. After being marked 47.25 points for his buck off of Brady Fielder in New York City, the powerful bovine competitor retook the No. 1 spot in the standings, and he currently leads No. 2 Fast Flow by a considerable two points.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS \*REVISED\* – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will *NO LONGER* be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders took the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

**THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT** – Kubota PBR Louisville, the seventeenth Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 42 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and all but those listed below are guaranteed to get on another bull in Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

The following riders from the Carolina Cowboys and the Nashville Stampede must ride on Friday to compete for the remainder of the weekend. Those riders are Eric Henrique Domingos (CAR), Murilo Henrique de Oliveira (CAR), Briggs Madsen (NSH), Caden Bunch (NSH) and Cody Jesus (NSH).

**NEXT UP** – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to the Acrisure Arena for Wrangler PBR Greater Palm Springs. The event will be on Friday, March 21, at 7:45 p.m. PT, Saturday, March 22, at 6:45 p.m. PT and Sunday, March 23, at 1:45 p.m. PT.

The end of Round 1 in Palm Springs will also feature the eleventh game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Oklahoma Wildcatters take on the Arizona Ridge Riders.

**VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS** – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
