MANCHVEGAS BUCKOFF – This weekend, the PBR’s elite Unleash The Beast heads to Manchester, New Hampshire, for the fifth event of the 24-event 2025 individual season, marking the fifth time in history, and the third consecutive season, the premier series has traveled to Manchester. SNHU Arena will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, December 20, at 7:45 p.m. ET, and Saturday, December 21, at 7:45 p.m. ET.

KASEL HANGS ON FOR FIRST EVENT WIN OF THE SEASON – After leading heading into the championship round in the first two events of the season before being overtaken, No. 2 Dalton Kasel was finally able to hold on to the top spot last weekend in Wichita, Kansas. Living up to his nickname, Mr. 90-point started strong, topping Lap Dancer for 90.75 points to win the opening round, later following up his dominant Round 1 victory by scoring 90.5 points on Mr. Right Now to win Round 2, thus extending his lead in the event heading into the championship round.

While Kasel got the pick of the pen, he already knew that he had captured his first victory of the 2025 season by the time he roared out of the gate on Doze You Down. The powerful bovine competitor bucked off Kasel after 3.18 seconds in the final out of the weekend to end the cowboy’s bid for perfection. Despite the final buckoff, the victory netted Kasel a critical 138 Unleash The Beast points to close the gap on No. 1 John Crimber to just 16 points. Kasel takes on Baldy in Round 1 in Manchester this weekend.

Crimber, who finished ninth after going 1-for-3, recorded his tour-best fourth 90-point ride of the season to maintain his spot atop the Unleash The Beast standings. After bucking off Sometimes I Fly in 5.82 seconds in Round 1, the 19-year-old rebounded in the second round, thundering out of the chutes for 90 points on Good Riddance. Looking to catapult to the top of the leaderboard for his third event win of the season, Crimber rocketed out of the gate on Man Hater in the championship round. However, the 2024 PBR YETI World Champion Bull proved too much for his cowboy counterpart, besting Crimber after 4.76 seconds. On Friday, the bull riding phenom looks to pad his lead in the Unleash The Beast standings on Oakie in Round 1.

HOLIDAY HIGHS – In addition to Kasel and Crimber, both No. 3 Sage Kimzey and No. 11 Dener Barbosa broke the 90-point barrier in Wichita, Kansas, last weekend. The best bull riders in the world have now combined for an impressive 14 90-point rides through the first four events of the season, six more than they had after four events in 2024.

Kimzey, who entered the event ranked No. 13 in the Unleash The Beast standings, was bucked off in 7.55 seconds by Big Choppa in Round 1 but roared back on the final day in Wichita, covering Down Payment for 89 points to qualify for the championship round. Kimzey scored an event-high 91.75 points on Nobody to catapult to second in the event standings and win his second round of the season. He battles Say When in the first round in Manchester, New Hampshire.

Four spots behind Kimzey in the event standings was Barbosa, who tallied the last of five 90-point rides inside INTRUST Bank Arena last weekend. The Brazilian hung on to Crime Scene for 83 points in Round 1 before careening out of the chutes atop Yahoo for 90.25 points in Round 2. Despite bucking off Reality Check in 2.35 seconds in his final out, Barbosa’s 2-for-3 performance netted him sixth, pushing him from No. 18 to No. 11 in the standings. He looks to continue his climb in the 2025 gold buckle race on Armageddon in the opening round on Friday.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of PBR Manchester will feature three rematches:

- Brady Fielder takes on Huckleberry for the second time after riding him for 73 points in Billings, Montana, earlier this year in April.
- Dalton Kasel looks to once again break the 90-point plateau atop Baldy, whom he rode for 90.25 points in Las Vegas, Nevada, in October.
- Paulo Eduardo Rossetto shares a chute with Chuck for the fourth time on Friday. The ambidextrous cowboy covered the powerful bovine competitor for 87 points in their first matchup in Corpus Christi, Texas, in May before Chuck bucked off Rossetto in 6.11 seconds in Greensboro, North Carolina, in September. The Brazilian was quick to get his revenge, riding the elite animal athlete for 88.5 points two days later in the Tar Heel State.

PAST MANCHESTER UTB EVENT WINNERS – Last December, Brady Fielder went 3-for-3 to win his first career premier series title. The Australian began his flawless performance aboard Tucker for 83 points in Round 1. Entering Saturday ranked outside of the Top 10 in the event standings, Fielder locked in, covering Air Shift for 86.25 points to catapult up the standings after finishing second in the round. Choosing UTZ BesTex Smokestack as his final animal athlete opponent, Fielder made the 8 for a monstrous, round-winning, event-high 91 points to overtake the lead.

Right on the Aussie cowboy's spurs was Kaique Pacheco, who also went 3-for-3. The 2018 PBR World Champion topped Squealin' Kitty for 84.25 points in Round 1 and One Man Gang for 84.75 points in Round 2. Pacheco sat tall atop Lapua for 85.75 points in the final round, but it was not enough to overtake Fielder. Pacheco takes on Sin City in Round 1 on Friday, while Fielder battles Huckleberry.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying seven Bull of the Event titles with only one other bovine competitor holding more than one (No. 3 Fast Flow, who has two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 5 bull scores in the standings after being marked 48.25 points for his buckoff of Clay Guiton in 3.10 seconds in St. Louis, Missouri, in December. While he sits No. 2 in the standings, .40 points ahead of No. 3 Fast Flow, the one animal athlete opponent ahead of him has only one of the eight outs required to qualify, while Man Hater has already posted eight qualified outs. Younts Brody's Pet holds the No. 1 spot after being marked 46.5 points for his buckoff of Alan de Souza in Tucson in his sole premier series out.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS *REVISED* – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will **NO LONGER** be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all

Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – PBR Manchester, the fifth Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 40 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1-2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
