

2025 PBR Unleash The Beast PBR Milwaukee Fiserv Forum – Milwaukee, Wisconsin Saturday, March 1 at 7:45 p.m. CT Sunday, March 2 at 1:45 p.m. CT

BREW CITY BUCKOFF – This weekend, PBR's elite 2025 Unleash The Beast returns to Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The fifteenth stop of the 24-event 2025 individual season is the sixth time and fourth consecutive season the top tour has bucked into Fiserv Forum. Milwaukee will host the PBR for two days of action on Saturday, March 1, at 7:45 p.m. CT, and Sunday, March 2, at 1:45 p.m. CT.

RICHARDSON RIDES TO VICTORY IN JACKSONVILLE – Austin Richardson went 3-for-3 to win his first event of the season in Jacksonville, Florida, last weekend to climb from No. 16 to No. 7 in the Unleash The Beast standings. The Texan rode Dangerous Medicine for 86.25 points in Round 1 before punching his ticket to the championship round by covering Hunting Trip for 87.5 points in Round 2. Sitting in third heading into the final round, Richardson then catapulted to the top of the leaderboard by moving in perfect time with Eyes On Me for an event-high 91.5 points in the championship round. Richardson, who is paired with I'll Make Ya Famous in Round 1 this weekend, now sits 269 points behind No. 1 Brady Fielder, who takes on Easy Labor.

Another one of the eight riders to ride all three of his bulls in Florida last weekend, Fielder topped Jail Bird for 87 points in Round 1 and Rafter P Construction's Smooth Over It for 86.75 points in Round 2. Choosing Big Chili as his final animal athlete opponent, the Australian topped the massive animal athlete for 90 points in the final round to seize the last spot on the podium and garner 73.5 Unleash The Beast points to strengthen his hold of the top spot in the 2025 gold buckle race.

Sandwiched between Fielder and Richardson was veteran Kaique Pacheco. After topping Mike's Motive for a round-winning 90.5 points in the opening round, the "Ice Man" rode Dark Thoughts for 88 points in Round 2. The 2018 PBR World Champion then completed his flawless weekend by riding Ricky Vaughn for 86 points in the championship round to finish second, shooting from No. 20 to No. 8 in the Unleash The Beast standings. He takes on Cowboy Train in Round 1 on Saturday.

Also of note was No. 5 Sage Steele Kimzey, who rode M.A.C.A. for 84.25 points in Round 1 and Sorrel's Pick for 84.75 points in Round 2 to earn the final spot in the championship round. Left with the always dangerous Red Demon, The Professor made it look easy, topping him for 91 points to skyrocket from twelfth to sixth in the event standings. He currently sits 210.75 points behind Fielder and tries to remain hot atop Skippy in the opening round inside Fiserv Forum.

In addition to the four riders listed above, No. 38 Thiago Salgado, who finished fourth, No. 2 John Crimber, who finished fifth, No. 14 Anderson de Oliveira, who finished seventh and No. 9 Sandro Batista, who finished eighth, all were a perfect 3-for-3 in Jacksonville. Combined, the PBR's best went 54-for-96 (56.25%) to ride more than 50% of their animal athlete counterparts for the second time this season after not doing so a single time in 2024.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of PBR Milwaukee features the following rematches:

- Cort McFadden takes on Down to Fly for the first time since making the 8 for 87 points in Denver, Colorado, in January.
- John Crimber battles Peterbilt once again after riding him for 89.25 points in Las Vegas, Nevada, last October.
- Keyshawn Whitehorse shares a chute with Lapua for the second time after covering him for 88.25 points in Salt Lake City, Utah, in February of 2024.
- Mason Taylor seeks revenge aboard Mr. Nasty after he was bucked off in 1.28 seconds in Newark, New Jersey, in September of 2021.
- Sage Kimzey is paired with Skippy for the second time after the duo posted 87 points in St. Louis, Missouri, in December of 2023.

PAST MILWAUKEE EVENT WINNERS – Caden Bunch went 2-for-3 to take home the event title the last time the PBR bucked in Fiserv Forum. Bunch tied for an opening round win with John Crimber by riding Cookies & Cream for 87 points before separating himself from the pack by covering Magic Trick for 86.75 points in Round 2. Despite being bucked off by Ricky Vaughn in 1.63 seconds in the championship round, Bunch had done enough to win the second event of his career.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying eight Bull of the Event titles with only two other bovine competitors holding more than one (No. 2 Fast Flow, who has three, and No. 5 Ridin' Salty, who has two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 5 bull scores in the standings after being marked 48.25 points for his buckoff of Clay Guiton in 3.10 seconds in St. Louis, Missouri, in December. After being marked 47.25 points for his buck off of Brady Fielder in New York City, the powerful bovine competitor retook the No. 1 spot in the standings, and he currently leads No. 2 Fast Flow by a considerable 1.94 points.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS *REVISED* – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will **NO LONGER** be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders took the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – PBR Milwaukee, the fifteenth Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 40 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Saturday and another bull in Round 2 on Sunday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Sunday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Simmons Bank Arena in North Little Rock, Arkansas, for PBR Little Rock. The event will be on Saturday, March 8, at 7:45 p.m. CT, and Sunday, March 9, at 1:45 p.m. CT.

The end of Round 1 in Little Rock will also feature the ninth game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Missouri Thunder take on the Kansas City Outlaws.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
