BACK TO BUCKING – This weekend, the PBR will launch the 2025 Unleash The Beast season in Tucson, Arizona, at Tucson Arena. The first event of the 24-event 2025 individual season will mark the sixth time in history the premier series has traveled to Tucson and the third consecutive year. The Grand Canyon State will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, November 15, at 6:45 p.m. MT and Saturday, November 16, at 6:45 p.m. MT.

FROM TEAMMATES TO RIVALS – As the PBR returns to individual competition with the conclusion of the third season of the PBR Camping World Team Series, there are several riders to keep an eye on competing in Tucson, Arizona:

Cassio Dias – The 2024 PBR World Champion continued to dominate for the Kansas City Outlaws during the 2024 PBR Teams season, going an impressive 20-for-34 (58.82%) during the regular season and finishing fifth in the MVP race. Along the way, Dias also made history aboard 2024 YETI World Champion Bull Man Hater, covering the powerful bovine competitor for a mammoth 98.25 points, the second-highest ride score in PBR history and the best in the PBR Teams league. Kansas City finished the regular season with a 19-9 record, the best in the league, but finished third after the dust settled at the 2025 PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas. Dias begins his championship defense on Washita Red in Round 1 on Friday.

Dalton Kasel – While Kasel only went 6-for-15 in the regular season for the Austin Gamblers, he caught fire in the postseason to help propel the Gamblers to the 2024 PBR Teams Championship. After starting 0-for-2, Kasel converted against the No. 2 Carolina Cowboys in Round 2 for 88.25 points on Snuggles to help lead Austin to a 349.75-166 victory. On Championship Sunday, Kasel continued to roll, riding Baldy for 90.25 points to lead the Gamblers to a 432.75-357.5 upset victory against the No. 1 Kansas City Outlaws. Austin's flawless 5-for-5 performance marked the first perfect game in team history and second in PBR Teams postseason history. Kasel again came up big in his final out in the Championship Game, covering Always Been Crazy for an event-best 92 points to help beat the Carolina Cowboys, 357.5-252.5, and earn the team's first championship buckle. Kasel shares a chute with Dangerous Medicine in the opening round Friday evening.

John Crimber – The young bull riding phenom became the first rider not named Jose Vitor Leme to win the PBR Teams MVP award during the 2024 season, going an incredible 28-for-42 (66.7%) and leading the league with six 90-point rides and six Shootout Round conversions. The first pick in the 2024 PBR Teams New Rider Draft by the Florida Freedom, coached by his father, Paulo, Crimber propelled the team to finish No. 3 in the regular season with a 16-12 record. After winning the MVP award, Crimber took his game to another level during the PBR Teams Championship, going an incredible 4-for-4, including a 90.75-point ride on Renegade in Florida's loss to the Carolina Cowboys in the Semifinals, to become the first rider in league history to win both regular-season MVP and PBR Teams Championship MVP in the same season. Crimber takes on Sucker Pop in Round 1 on Friday.

Sandro Batista – After not competing during the 2024 Unleash The Beast campaign, Batista had a breakout season with the Kansas City Outlaws. Riding primarily in the leadoff position, Batista went an impressive 22-for-33 (66.67%) and finished third in the MVP race. At the end of August, the Brazilian went on an eight-out ride streak, culminating in his

season-best 90.25-point performance atop Ugly This in a 264.5-88 Kansas City victory against the eventual 2025 PBR Teams Champion Austin Gamblers during Kansas City's homestand. Batista looks to carry over his PBR Teams success to the elite Unleash The Beast on Tchoupitoulas in the opening round on Friday.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season begins Friday night in Tucson, Arizona, keeping the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removing PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events. In addition, for each point a rider earns at a lower-level event, a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will be awarded. For example, if a rider earns 100 points by winning a Velocity Tour event, they will earn 25 points in the Unleash The Beast standings, which gives riders a baseline to start from if they make the top tour. A rider will not appear in the Unleash The Beast standings until they have debuted at a 2025 Unleash The Beast event.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut takes place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

LET'S TALK QUALIFIERS – As the new Unleash The Beast (UTB) season gets underway, below is the qualification system when competition begins in Tucson. The field is determined via a combination of factors, including a rider's performance on the PBR Team Camping World Team Series, which concluded its third season in late October.

Here are the criteria the PBR will use to determine the riders who will compete at the first four Unleash The Beast events in Tucson, Ontario, St. Louis and Wichita:

- All PBR World Champions who competed in at least one 2024 UTB event and/or qualified for the 2024 PBR World Finals.
- The Top 15 riders from the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series MVP standings who are not already qualified through PBR World Champion status. The Top 15 was determined by the cumulative ride scores of individual riders across all outs at PBR Teams events, including the Shootout Round and PBR Teams Championship events during the season.
- The Top 5 riders from the 2024 PBR Challenger Series standings who are not already qualified through the above criteria will earn qualification. For clarity, if one of the Top 5 riders in the Challenger Series standings is already qualified, the rider ranked No. 6 will then get the position, and so on.
- The two highest-ranking riders who finished in the Top 40 in the 2024 PBR world standings who also competed in the previous year's PBR World Finals and are not already qualified through any of the above scenarios.
- Ten riders selected by their respective teams from the year-end active rosters.
- Any remaining positions will be filled with a maximum of 10 additional riders based on the PBR Teams cumulative ride score standings, who must have finished in the Top 40 in the previous year's PBR world standings and/or competed in the previous year's PBR World Finals.

Following the first four events, the Unleash The Beast field will be set via the tour's standings and subject to the rolling cuts as identified above.

- Andrew Alvidrez takes on Taylor's Cowtown Throwdown for the first time since he was bucked off in a heartbreaking 7.93 seconds in Billings, Montana, in April.
- Keyshawn Whitehorse battles Highwire once again after the powerful bovine competitor bested him in 3.26 seconds in Fort Worth, Texas, in May.
- Mason Taylor and Sky's The Limit dance for a second time after the duo posted 88.25 points in New York City in January of 2023.

PAST TUCSON EVENT WINNERS – In a thrilling opener to the 2024 Unleash The Beast Season, Caden Bunch rode supreme to take home his first Unleash The Beast event title. The young Oklahoman was one of six riders to go a perfect 3-for-3 after he rode Ah Hell for 86 points in Round 1, Mighty Mike for 88.25 points in Round 2, and Concho for a walk-off-worthy 89.25 points in the championship round. Bunch's performance netted him the event victory by just half a point over veterans Joao Ricardo Vieira and Sage Steele Kimzey, who split second and also went 3-for-3. Jose Vitor Leme, Cody Jesus, and Cassio Dias were the other riders who put together a flawless opening weekend in Arizona, finishing fourth, fifth, and sixth, respectively. WORLD CHAMPION BULL UPDATE – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs, and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – PBR Tucson in Tucson, Arizona, the first Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 40 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1-2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Toyota Arena in Ontario, California, for PBR Ontario. The event will be on Saturday, November 23, at 6:45 p.m. PT and Sunday, November 24, at 11:45 a.m. PT.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
