

2025 PBR Unleash The Beast PBR Chicago

Allstate Arena – Rosemont, Illinois Friday, January 10 at 7:45 p.m. CST Saturday, January 11 at 7:45 p.m. CST

BUCKING BY THE BEAN – This weekend, PBR's elite 2025 Unleash The Beast returns to Allstate Arena in Rosemont, Illinois. The eighth stop of the 24-event 2025 individual season will mark the 15th time in history and the second consecutive season the premier series has traveled to the Windy City. Chicago will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, January 10, at 7:45 p.m. CST, and Saturday, January 11, at 7:45 p.m. CST.

SOME GUYS HAVE ALL THE LUCK – No. 4 Lucas Divino was .04 seconds away from a perfect 4-for-4 weekend inside Madison Square Garden in New York City last weekend to take home his first event win of the season. After bucking off Umm in a heartbreaking 7.96 seconds in Round 1, the Brazilian bounced back, riding Fierce's Dirtnap for 86.25 points in Round 2. Knowing he needed to make the 8 in order to punch his ticket to the championship round, Divino converted for 87.25 points aboard Pack Rat in Round 3. The Austin Gamblers' veteran capped off his weekend with an 88.75-point ride on Punchy Pete in the championship round to climb to the top of the leaderboard. His first victory since 2020 netted Divino 145 points in the Unleash The Beast standings, skyrocketing him from No. 15 to No. 4, now 129.5 points behind No. 1 John Crimber. "Lucky" Lucas Divino attempts to keep the odds in his favor atop Hector in Round 1 on Friday.

While he maintained his spot atop the standings for the seventh-consecutive week, Crimber only made the 8 once in New York. The Texan was bucked off by Whiskey Trip in 4.59 seconds in Round 1 but bounced back to cover Crazy Party for 85.5 points in Round 2. However, Crimber was kept out of the championship round by I'll Make Ya Famous in Round 3, bested in 4.9 seconds. Crimber looks to maintain his spot atop the standings by taking on Gunsmoke in the opening round this weekend.

MR. 1000 – No. 31 Joao Ricardo Vieira's out against Sin City in Round 1 on Friday will make the veteran's 1,000th career premier series out, making him the fifth cowboy in PBR history to reach the millennial milestone, joining 2004 PBR World Champion Mike Lee (1,181), three-time PBR World Champion Silvano Alves (1,175), 2008 PBR World Champion Guilherme Marchi (1,174) and two-time PBR World Champion J.B. Mauney (1,086). Still in search of his first gold buckle at the age of 40, the 2013 Rookie of the Year went 1-for-3 to finish 21st in New York City last weekend, topping Wild Card for 87.25 points in Round 1. The 2023 PBR Teams Championship MVP with the Texas Rattlers is currently 6-for-14 (42.9%) on the season.

MONSTER ENERGY TEAM CHALLENGE – This weekend features the second game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Carolina Cowboys take on the Nashville Stampede.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of PBR Chicago features six rematches:

- Brady Fielder takes on DirtyBru for the second time after bucking off in 3.7 seconds in Albany, New York, in December of 2023.
- Joao Ricardo Vieira runs it back against Sin City after covering the animal athlete for 82.5 points in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, in February of 2019.
- John Crimber tries to make the 8 aboard Gunsmoke for a second time after riding him for 87.5 points in Greensboro, North Carolina, last September.
- Lucas Divino battles Hector for the first time since being bucked off in 2.5 seconds in Manchester, New Hampshire, last December.
- Manoelito de Souza Junior and God Bless America share a chute once again after the Brazilian cowboy was bucked off in 6.54 seconds in Fort Worth, Texas, in May of 2022.
- Mason Taylor dances with Black Panther once again after moving in perfect time with the powerful bovine competitor for 88.5 points in their first meeting in Bismarck, North Dakota, last June.

PAST CHICAGO EVENT WINNERS – When the PBR Unleash The Beast last bucked into Allstate Arena in January 2024, Cassio Dias went 3-for-3. The Brazilian covered IHOP for 87 points in the opening round before securing the second pick heading into the championship round by riding Grey Fox for 86.75 points in Round 2. Choosing Do Dat Eddie as his final animal athlete opponent, Dias tied for the round-win with an event-high 89 points. The victory propelled Dias back to the top of the Unleash The Beast standings, a spot he would hold for the remainder of the season to secure his first gold buckle.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying eight Bull of the Event titles with only one other bovine competitor holding more than one (No. 3 Fast Flow, who has two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 5 bull scores in the standings after being marked 48.25 points for his buckoff of Clay Guiton in 3.10 seconds in St. Louis, Missouri, in December. After being marked 47.25 points for his buck off of Brady Fielder in New York City, the powerful bovine competitor retook the No. 1 spot in the standings, leading No. 2 Younts Brody's Pet, who only has one out, by a considerable 1.38 points.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS *REVISED* – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will *NO LONGER* be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders took the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – PBR Chicago, the eighth Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 44 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and all but those listed below are guaranteed to get on a second bull in Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

The following four riders from the Carolina Cowboys and Nashville Stampede must ride on Friday in order to compete for the remainder of the weekend. Those four riders are: Andrei Scoparo (CAR), Ethan Winckler (CAR), Briggs Madsen (NSH) and Cody Jesus (NSH).

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Toyota Center in Houston, Texas, for Michelob ULTRA PBR Houston. The event will be on Friday, January 17, at 7:45 p.m. CT, and Saturday, January 18, at 7:45 p.m. CT.

PROVIDING PROTECTION – This weekend's bull fighters are Nathan Harp of Tuttle, Oklahoma; Lucas Teodoro of Pinhal, Brazil; and Cody Webster of Wayne, Oklahoma.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.

- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
