**QUEEN CITY BUCKOFF** – This weekend, PBR's elite 2025 Unleash The Beast returns to Sioux Falls, South Dakota. The twentieth stop of the 24-event 2025 individual season is the tenth time and fifth consecutive season the top tour has visited Sioux Falls. Denny Sanford PREMIER Center will host the PBR for three days of action on Friday, April 4, at 7:45 p.m. CT, Saturday, April 5, at 7:45 p.m. CT and Sunday, April 6, at 1:45 p.m. CT.

**PAULO EDUARDO ROSSETTO WINS FIRST CAREER PREMIER SERIES EVENT IN THE PIT** – Switchhanded rider Paulo Eduardo Rossetto went 3-for-4 to win the first premier series event of his career in Albuquerque, New Mexico, last weekend. The Brazilian began his weekend by riding Mr. Demon for a round-winning 90.75 points in Round 1 before covering One Chance for 88.5 points in Round 2. Now on a roll, the ambidextrous Rossetto topped Judgement Day for 87.25 points in Round 3. Despite bucking off Nobody in 2.66 seconds in the championship round, Rossetto had done enough to take home the event title. After climbing from No. 12 to No. 6 in the Unleash The Beast standings, Rossetto takes on Good Riddance in Round 1 on Friday.

Also of note were the performances by No. 17 Eduardo Aparecido and No. 11 Leonardo Castro, who finished second and third, respectively. Aparecido topped King Tut for 90.5 points in Round 1 but was bucked off by Sucker Pop in 1.9 seconds in Round 2. The veteran rebounded in Round 3, riding Hunter for 87 points before making the 8 aboard UTZ BesTex Smokestack for 88 points in the championship round. Castro proved his mettle by bouncing back after bucking off Constant Payne in 2.43 seconds in Round 1. Finding his groove, Castro rode Yo Mamma for 86.25 points in Round 2, Big X for 85.25 points in Round 3 and Top Dollar for 89.5 points in the championship round. Castro attempts to extend his ride streak to four atop Rip in Round 1 this weekend, while Aparecido takes on Air Marshall.

**MONSTER ENERGY TEAM CHALLENGE** – This weekend features the thirteenth game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Carolina Cowboys battle the Nashville Stampede.

**FAMILIAR WATERS** – Round 1 of PREMIER Bankcard PBR Sioux Falls, presented by Cooper Tires, features the following rematches:

- Andrew Alvidrez returns after missing last weekend due to injury to take on Magic Touch, who bucked off the former power lifter in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, in 6.72 seconds last April.
- Bruno Carvalho runs it back against Buffalo Heifer, who bested him in 7.48 seconds in Springfield, Missouri, in August of 2024 before bucking him off in 5.63 seconds the following day.
- Dener Barbosa settles the score with Rockville in Round 1. The elite animal athlete bucked off Barbosa in 7.53 seconds in Manchester, New Hampshire, in December of 2022 before the Brazilian rode him for 86.5 points in Duluth, Georgia, in January of 2023.
- Elizmar Jeremias takes on Sly for the second time after he was bucked off in 5.05 seconds in Indianapolis, Indiana, on Valentine's Day of this year.
- John Crimber shares a chute with El Chapo for the first time since he was bucked off in 3.06 seconds in Indianapolis in February.
- Mason Taylor dances with Hoobastank for the third time. The Texan made the 8 for 84 points in their first matchup in Hampton, Virginia, in February of 2024 before being bucked off in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in 1.91 seconds in January.

**PAST SIOUX FALLS EVENT WINNERS** – Last year in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, Cassio Dias won his sixth event of the season with a 3-for-4 performance. In Round 1, Dias roared out of the gates on Miller Time but was bucked off in 6.26 seconds. Undeterred, the Brazilian rebounded and recorded three straight rides, sitting tall atop Medicine Red for 84.5 points in Round 2 and Blown Away for 87 points in Round 3. Now in top form, Dias stole the show with a monstrous, round-winning, event-high 90.5 points on Ricky Vaughn, his eighth 90-point ride of the season, to close out the victory.

**WORLD CHAMPION BULL** – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying eleven Bull of the Event titles with only two other bovine competitors holding more than one (No. 2 Fast Flow, who has three, and No. 5 Ridin' Salty, who has two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 5 bull scores in the standings after being marked 48.25 points for his buckoff of Clay Guiton in 3.10 seconds in St. Louis, Missouri, in December. After being marked 47.25 points for his buck off of Brady Fielder in New York City, the powerful bovine competitor retook the No. 1 spot in the standings, and he currently leads No. 2 Fast Flow by a considerable 1.94 points.

**2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS \*REVISED\*** – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will <u>NO LONGER</u> be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders took the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

**THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT** – PREMIER Bankcard PBR Sioux Falls, presented by Cooper Tires, the twentieth Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature four rounds of bull riding. Each of the 44 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and all but those listed below are guaranteed to get on another bull in Round 2 on Saturday and Round 3 on Sunday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1, 2, and 3 will then advance to the championship round following Round 3 on Sunday.

The following riders from the Carolina Cowboys and Nashville Stampede must ride on Friday to compete for the remainder of the weekend. Those riders are Briggs Madsen (NSH), Caden Bunch (NSH), Vitor Manoel Dias (NSH), Eric Henrique Domingos (CAR) and Murilo Henrique de Oliveira (CAR).

**NEXT UP** – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to the First Interstate Arena at MetraPark for Cooper Tires PBR Billings. The event will be on Friday, April 11, at 7:45 p.m. MT, and Saturday, April 12, at 6:45 p.m. MT.

**VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS** – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
