

2025 PBR Unleash The Beast Ariat PBR Indianapolis Presented by Cooper Tires Gainbridge Fieldhouse – Indianapolis, Indiana Friday, February 14 at 7:45 p.m. ET Saturday, February 15 at 6:45 p.m. ET

NAPTOWN SHOWDOWN – This weekend, PBR's elite 2025 Unleash The Beast returns to Indianapolis, Indiana. The thirteenth stop of the 24-event 2025 individual season is the sixth time and fourth consecutive season the top tour has bucked into Indianapolis. Gainbridge Fieldhouse will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, February 14, at 7:45 p.m. ET, and Saturday, February 15, at 6:45 p.m. ET.

EDUARDO APARECIDO TAKES HOME EVENT TITLE IN SALT LAKE CITY – Eduardo Aparecido went 3-for-3 to win PBR Salt Lake City. The Brazilian cowboy rode Off The Tracks for 87 points in Round 1 before covering Buckaroo for 86.5 points in the second round. Choosing Ricky Vaughn as his final animal athlete opponent, he again made the 8, this time for 90.25 points, to complete his perfect weekend and garner his first win of the season. Aparecido shot from No. 37 to No. 18 in the Unleash The Beast standings, and "Fast Eddy" attempts to keep it rolling on Lapua in Round 1 on Friday.

Aparecido currently sits 341 points behind No. 1 Brady Fielder, who went 1-for-3 and finished eighth last weekend. The Aussie topped Dirty Dave for 88.5 points in Round 1 but was bucked off by Bamboozle in 3.82 seconds during Round 2 and in 7.7 seconds by Buck Nasty in his final out. He looks to extend his lead in the 2025 gold buckle race atop Time For Magic in the opening round in Indianapolis.

No. 6 Sage Steele Kimzey also had an impressive weekend in Salt Lake City, finishing second by covering all three of his animal athlete opponents. After hanging onto Tropic Thunder in Round 1 for 83.25 points, Kimzey climbed the leaderboard by riding No Man's Land for 86.25 points in Round 2. He then rode Playmate for an event-high 91 points in the championship round to take the second spot on the podium. Kimzey shares a chute with Designated Survivor in Round 1 this weekend.

MONSTER ENERGY TEAM CHALLENGE – This weekend features the seventh game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Kansas City Outlaws face off against the Missouri Thunder.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of Ariat PBR Indianapolis, presented by Cooper Tires, features one rematch:

PAST INDIANAPOLIS WINNERS – When the elite Unleash The Beast last bucked into Gainbridge Fieldhouse, Dalton Kasel went 3-for-3 to take home the event title. Paired with Dream Walkin in the opening round, the Texan tied for third in the opening round by posting 86.25 points. Kasel then matched his Round 1 performance by riding Unhinged for another 86.25 points. In the championship round, he converted for a third time, covering I'm Legit Too for 88.25 points to win the event.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying eight Bull of the Event titles with only two other bovine competitors holding more than one (No. 2 Fast Flow, who has three, and No. 5 Ridin' Salty, who has two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 5 bull scores in the standings after being marked 48.25 points for his buckoff of Clay Guiton in 3.10 seconds in St. Louis, Missouri, in December. After being marked 47.25 points for his buck off of Brady Fielder in New York City, the powerful bovine competitor retook the No. 1 spot in the standings, and he currently leads No. 2 Fast Flow by a considerable 1.94 points.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS *REVISED* – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will *NO LONGER* be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders took the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – Ariat PBR Indianapolis, presented by Cooper Tires, the thirteenth Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 43 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and all but those listed below are guaranteed to get on another bull in Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

The following four riders from the Kansas City Outlaws and Missouri Thunder must ride on Friday to compete for the remainder of the weekend. Those riders are: Carlos Andre de Oliveira (KC), Maikon Calixton Rocha (KC), Marcus Mast (KC) and Casey Roberts (MO).

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to VyStar Veterans Memorial Arena in Jacksonville, Florida, for Michelob ULTRA PBR Jacksonville. The event will be on Saturday, February 22, at 7:45 p.m. ET, and Sunday, February 23, at 2:45 p.m. ET.

The end of Round 1 in Jacksonville will also feature the eighth game of the Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, with the New York Mavericks taking on the Florida Freedom.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
