MAGIC CITY BUCKOFF – This weekend, PBR's elite 2025 Unleash The Beast returns to Billings, Montana. The twenty-first stop of the 24-event 2025 individual season is the 30th time the top tour has visited Billings. First Interstate Arena at MetraPark will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, April 11, at 7:45 p.m. MDT and Saturday, April 12, at 6:45 p.m. MDT.

CLAY GUITON WINS FIRST CAREER PREMIER SERIES EVENT IN SIOUX FALLS – Clay Guiton went 4-for-4 to win his first career event in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, last weekend to climb to No. 10 in the Unleash The Beast standings. The North Carolinian topped I Hate You for 87 points in Round 1 before riding Mouse Trap for 87.75 points in Round 2. Now in a groove, Guiton covered Tijuana Two-Step for 85.25 points in Round 3 before completing his perfect weekend by riding Eyes On Me for 87 points in the championship round. Guiton attempts to make it five in a row atop Haunted Hotel in Round 1 on Friday.

Maintaining his spot atop the Unleash The Beast standings for the third consecutive week, No. 1 Dalton Kasel went 3-for-4 and finished second. The Texan rode Simon for 88.25 points in Round 1 but was bucked off by Big Red Train in 3.19 seconds in Round 2. Kasel rebounded in Round 3, riding Let Him Fly for 88.5 points, before living up to his "Mr. 90-Point" nickname in the championship round by dancing with 2024 PBR YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater for 93.5 points as the bovine competitor continues to dominate with a 48-point average bull score in 2025 (1.94 points ahead of Fast Flow) en route to a seemingly inevitable second consecutive title. Kasel takes on Regular Joe in the opening round in Billings this weekend.

Also of note was the performance of No. 7 Cort McFadden, who went 3-for-4 and finished fifth. Despite bucking off Slingin' It in 5.73 seconds in Round 1, the Texan proved his mettle by closing his weekend 3-for-3, topping Air Shift for 84.75 points in Round 2, Blown Away for 86.5 points in Round 3 and Mercy for 87.25 points in the championship round. McFadden, whose father Cory McFadden famously rode Little Yellow Jacket for 95.5 points in Billings in April of 2002, battles Kwik Lock in Round 1.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of Cooper Tires PBR Billings features the following rematch:

- Kaiden Loud takes on Chute Boss for the second time after bucking off in 3.81 seconds in Manchester, New Hampshire, in December of 2023.

PAST BILLINGS EVENT WINNERS – Last year Eduardo Aparecido went 3-for-4 to win in Billings, Montana. Tasked with Wild Card in the opening round, Aparecido made the 8 for 88.5 points. Now in a groove, "Fast Eddy" covered Benjamin Ranklin for 85.25 points in Round 2 before being bucked off by Cy Young in 5.67 seconds in Round 3. Undeterred, Aparecido roared back to ride Flyin' Wired for a round-winning 89.25 points to cap off the event win.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying twelve Bull of the Event titles with only two other bovine competitors holding more than one (No. 2 Fast Flow, who has three, and No. 5 Ridin' Salty, who has two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 7 bull scores in the standings after being marked 47 points for his buck off of Clay Guiton in 3.88 seconds in Louisville, Kentucky, in March. After being marked 47.25 points for his buck off of Brady Fielder in New York City, the powerful bovine competitor retook the No. 1 spot in the standings, and he currently leads No. 2 Fast Flow by a considerable 1.94 points.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS *REVISED* – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most

Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will *NO LONGER* be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders took the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – Cooper Tires PBR Billings, the twenty-first Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 41 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and one bull in Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to the Ford Idaho Center for Progressive PBR Nampa. The event will take place Friday, April 18, at 7:45 p.m. MT, and Saturday, April 19, at 6:45 p.m. MT.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
