GEM STATE HOEDOWN – This weekend, PBR's elite 2025 Unleash The Beast returns to Nampa, Idaho. The twenty-second stop of the 24-event 2025 individual season serves as the 28th time the top tour has visited Nampa, and the 14th consecutive season. The Ford Idaho Center will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, April 18, at 7:45 p.m. MDT and Saturday, April 19, at 6:45 p.m. MDT.

LUCIANO DE CASTRO WALKS-OFF VICTORIOUS IN BILLINGS – Luciano De Castro went 3-for-3 to win his second event of the season in Billings, Montana, last weekend. The Brazilian topped Night Agent for 88.5 points in Round 1 before winning the second round by riding Oyster Creek Brawler for 88.75 points in Round 2. Castro completed his perfect weekend by covering Lights Out for 87.25 points for a walk-off victory in the championship round, propelling him from No. 8 to No. 5 in the Unleash The Beast standings with just two events left before the 2025 PBR World Finals: Unleash The Beast. Castro, now 405.17 points off the No. 1 ranking, attempts to keep it rolling aboard Jolene's Dream in Round 1 on Friday.

KASEL AND FIELDER HOLD TIGHT AT TOP – SEPARATED BY ONLY 36 POINTS – Maintaining his spot atop the Unleash The Beast standings for the fourth consecutive week, No. 1 Dalton Kasel went 1-for-3 to finish tied for 12th. After riding Whiplash for 88.25 points in Round 1, the 2025 gold buckle frontrunner was bucked off by Hunter in 5.74 seconds in Round 2 and Cool Whip in 5.01 seconds during the championship round. Right ahead of Kasel in the event standings was No. 2 Brady Fielder, who also went 1-for-3 and finished 11th. The Aussie rode Lieutenant Dan for an event-high 89 points in the opening round before being bucked off by Magic Spider in 7.11 seconds in Round 2 and by Buck Nasty in 3.82 seconds during the championship round. The two face off in the third Land.com Texas Cup matchup of the season as part of the Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, Friday night as Kasel attempts Whip for the Austin Gamblers in Round 1, while the Texas Rattlers' Fielder takes on Project X.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the Progressive PBR Nampa features the following rematches:

- Adriano Salgado battles No Socks for the second time after making the 8 for 85.25 points in Palm Springs, California, in March.
- Alan de Souza faces off against Smoke Down for the third time. Souza rode him for 85.5 points in Fort Worth, Texas, in May of 2023 before covering him again for 86.75 points in Everett, Washington, in April of 2024.
- Conner Halverson takes on Johnny Rocket for the first time since bucking off in 5.78 seconds in Fort Worth, Texas, in November of 2022.
- Dalton Kasel battles Whip for the second time after being bucked off in 4.36 seconds in Winston-Salem, North Carolina, in September of 2022.
- Kaique Pacheco dances with HomeBru once again after bucking off him in 4.09 seconds in Nampa, Idaho, in April of 2021.
- Paulo Eduardo Rossetto shares a chute with Alakazoo for the second time after riding him for 86.5 points in Sacramento, California, earlier this year in February.

PAST BILLINGS EVENT WINNERS – In 2024, Thiago Salgado went a perfect 4-for-4 to take home the event buckle in Nampa, Idaho. After riding Rockville for 86 points in Round 1, Salgado hung onto Time Bomb for 68.5 points in Round 2. Knowing he needed to make the 8 two more times to have a shot at the event title, the Brazilian came in clutch on championship Sunday, topping Bubba G for 83.25 points in Round 3 and Brusta for 88.75 points in the championship round. Salgado returns to defend his crown, taking on Good Riddance in Round 1.

In 2004, Michael Gaffney rode Little Yellow Jacket for a historic 96.5 points in Nampa. The ride was tied for the top score in PBR history until 2021 when Jose Vitor Leme shattered the record twice aboard Woopaa, first marked 97.75 points during the July Bucking Battle in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and then an unprecedented 98.75 points during the championship round of the World Finals.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying twelve Bull of the Event titles with only two other bovine competitors holding more than one (No. 2 Fast Flow, who has three, and No. 5 Ridin' Salty, who has two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 7 bull scores in the standings after being marked 47 points for his buck off of Clay Guiton in 3.88 seconds in Louisville, Kentucky, in March. After being marked 47.25 points for his buck off of Brady Fielder in New York City, the powerful bovine competitor retook the No. 1 spot in the standings, and he currently leads No. 2 Fast Flow by a considerable 1.94 points.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS *REVISED* – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will ***NO LONGER*** be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the

Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders took the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – Progressive PBR Nampa, the twenty-second Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 40 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and all but the rider listed below are guaranteed to get on another bull in Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

The Texas Rattlers' Marcelo Procopio Pereira must ride on Friday in order to compete for the rest of the weekend.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to the Tacoma Dome for PBR Tacoma. The event will take place Saturday, April 26, at 7:45 p.m. PT, and Sunday, April 27, at 6:45 p.m. PT.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
