

2025 PBR World Finals: Unleash The Beast Eliminations

Fort Worth, Texas – Cowtown Coliseum Thursday, May 8 at 7:45 p.m. CT Friday, May 9 at 7:45 p.m. CT Saturday, May 10 at 7:45 p.m. CT Sunday, May 11 at 1:45 p.m. CT

CROWNING A CHAMPION – The PBR World Finals returns to the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex for the fourth consecutive season with the same three-stage format as 2024, which begins with Eliminations May 8-11 and Ride For Redemption May 14-15 at Cowtown Coliseum in Fort Worth, Texas, before concluding with the PBR World Finals: Championship inside AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas, May 17-18.

The first stage of the PBR World Finals at Cowtown Coliseum, Eliminations, begins Thursday, May 8, at 7:45 p.m. CT, Friday, May 9, at 7:45 p.m. CT, Saturday, May 10, at 7:45 p.m. CT, and Sunday, May 11, at 1:45 p.m. CT.

The action inside the historic arena where the PBR hosted its first event in 1993 continues with Ride For Redemption on Wednesday, May 14, at 7:45 p.m. CT and Thursday, May 15, at 7:45 p.m. CT.

Then, following Kid Rock's Rock N Rodeo on Friday, May 16, the PBR World Finals: Championship takes over the home of the Dallas Cowboys in Arlington beginning Saturday, May 17, at 7:45 p.m. CT and Sunday, May 18, at 1:45 p.m. CT.

The World Finals is the richest bull riding event in the sport, with the 2025 event set to award a record-setting \$3.26 million in prize money, which includes a \$1 million bonus awarded to the rider who is crowned the PBR World Champion.

NO. 1 KASEL ENTERS PBR WORLD FINALS WITH 126-POINT LEAD OVER NO. 2 FIELDER – No. 1 Dalton Kasel looks to hold onto his 126-point lead over No. 2 Brady Fielder to win his first gold buckle after winning a tour-best five events during the 2025 regular season. The Muleshoe, Texas, native went 33-for-60 (55%) throughout the campaign, including a tour-best-tying five 90-point rides. Right on his spurs, Fielder went an impressive 40-for-61 (65.6%) to lead the tour in riding percentage in 2025, recording seven round wins, second only to Kasel's incredible fourteen round victories.

Fielder, who is looking to become the second Australian to win the PBR World Title (Troy Dunn – 1998) sat atop the standings for eight consecutive weeks before Kasel surged up the standings by winning three straight events, capped by a 4-for-4 performance in Palm Desert, California, to seize the lead in the 2025 Unleash The Beast standings. The Texas cowboy has led the gold buckle race ever since, though Fielder has never trailed by more than 187 points. Kasel is paired with Good Riddance in Round 1 of *Eliminations*, while Fielder takes on Lap Dancer.

The only other rider to hold the top spot in the Unleash The Beast standings is No. 3 John Crimber, who enters his second PBR World Finals 483 points behind Kasel. After winning the opening event of the season in Tucson, Arizona, in November, Crimber led for the first nine weeks of the season* before being overtaken by Fielder following his victory in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in January. Crimber is tied with Kasel with a tour-best five 90-point rides and is tied with No. 8 Keyshawn Whitehorse for third on the tour with six round wins, trailing only Fielder and Kasel. The young phenom is attempting to become the youngest PBR champion in history and has a proven track record of performing at the World Finals, as he won the Lane Frost/Brent Thurman Award in 2024 by riding Big Bank for an incredible 95 points inside AT&T Stadium last year, tied for the 10th highest score in PBR World Finals history. Crimber is paired with Spunky Energy in Round 1 on Thursday.

Rounding out a tightly-packed Top 5 of the Unleash The Beast standings are No. 4 Sage Steele Kimzey and No. 5 Luciano De Castro. Kimzey, the 2024 PBR World Finals event champion, sits 489.75 points behind Kasel. The seventime PRCA Champion is second on tour in riding percentage (31-for-53, 58.5%), and won the event in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, in March. Castro, who is tied with Kimzey for sixth on tour with four round wins, is 566.17 points behind Kasel. The Arizona Ridge Riders standout won the event in Billings, Montana, in April, to better position himself to make a run at his first gold buckle. Kimzey attempts to surge up the standings aboard Big Lean in the first round of *Eliminations* while Castro battles Electric Kitty Thursday night.

*After the PBR updated the 2025 points system in December, Kasel retroactively was the leader in the Unleash The Beast standings after the second event of the season before being overtaken by Crimber in Week 3.

KEYSHAWN WHITEHORSE WINS FINAL REGULAR SEASON EVENT IN TACOMA – Veteran Keyshawn Whitehorse won his second career premier series event in Tacoma, Washington, during the final week of the 2025 regular season to climb from No. 11 to No. 8 in the Unleash The Beast standings entering the 2025 PBR World Finals. The rider from the Navajo Nation topped Badlands for 88 points in Round 1 and Deep Creek for 86.75 points in Round 2 to enter the final round atop the event leaderboard. Whitehorse completed his perfect weekend by covering Mike's Motive for 89.5 points in the championship round, winning his first event of the season in walk-off fashion. Appearing in his eighth World Finals in 2025, Whitehorse looks to climb the standings on Mr. Demon in Round 1 on Thursday.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the PBR World Finals – *Eliminations* features the following rematches:

- Brady Fielder attempts to cover Lap Dancer for the second time this season after riding him for 88.25 points in Houston, Texas, in January.
- Dawson Branton faces off with Workin' Man once again after bucking off in 7.11 seconds in Greensboro, North Carolina, in September of 2024.
- Sandro Batista takes on Constant Payne for the first time since covering him for 87.25 points in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, in March of 2025.
- Thiago Salgado shares a chute with Tchoupitoulas, who bested the Brazilian cowboy in 3.27 seconds in their first meeting in Billings, Montana, in April of 2024.

VELOCITY ADDITIONS – Five qualifiers from the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (PWVT) will join the other 40 qualifiers for the PBR World Finals – *Eliminations*. Those five riders are Marcus Mast, Afonso Quintino, Bob Mitchell, Michael Lane and Ashton Sahli.

Mast qualified for his third career PBR World Finals as the 2025 Velocity Tour Champion. The grizzled veteran entered the PWVT Finals ranked No. 3 in the Velocity Global standings, trailing No. 1 Quintino by 125.5 points. He began his rise up the standings in Round 1 of the event in Corpus Christi, Texas, as he delivered the fourth-best score, riding Vigilante for 86.25 points to close the gap to within 101.5 points of the top spot.

On Championship Saturday, Mast punched his ticket to the championship round by covering Shakira for 80.5 points. In the championship round, Mast was paired with Watch Out, needing to finish third or better in the event aggregate to win the Velocity Tour Championship. The Indiana native did just that, making the 8 for 64.75 points and declining his re-ride opportunity. Mast finished third in the event aggregate, topping No. 2 Quintino by 12.5 Velocity Global points.

In addition to Mast, Quintino and Bob Mitchell will compete at the World Finals via their final rank in the Velocity Global standings. Quintino concluded the season No. 2, while Mitchell was No. 3.

Jean Fernandes Pereira earned one of the coveted spots as the top finishing rider at the event, not already qualified, by riding all three of his bovine athletes in Corpus Christi, concluding the event second. However, he was injured and ruled out, now set to be replaced by veteran Michael Lane.

Canadian Sahli will make his World Finals debut after earning the international invite at the year-end event courtesy of his rank in the Velocity Global standings.

NO. 6 PAULO EDUARDO ROSSETTO WINS VELOCITY TOUR FINALS – No. 6 Paulo Eduardo Rossetto went a perfect 3-for-3 to win the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Finals event in Corpus Christi, Texas, last weekend. The ambidextrous Brazilian rode Sizmagraf for 84.5 points in Round 1 before sitting tall atop Sweet John for 82.25 points in Round 2. Now in a groove, Rossetto completed his flawless weekend by riding Dough Boy for 86.25 points in the championship round to take home the event title. The Brazilian enters his second career PBR World Finals 567.75 points behind No. 1 Kasel and takes on Washita Lighting in Round 1 on Thursday.

FIGHT FOR THE TOP 15 – In one of the most tightly packed Top 25s in PBR World finals history, no rider wants to be bumped outside of the Top 15 following the *Eliminations* stage. No. 15 Eduardo Aparecido currently holds the final guaranteed spot at the PBR World Finals – *Championship* entering the opening stage, but eight riders are within just one round win of overtaking the veteran. Of those riders, the most notable is probably two-time PBR World Champion No. 18 Jose Vitor Leme, who is paired with Dana White's Playmate in Round 1 of *Eliminations*. Leme, who missed all of February and March due to injury, finished the season strong, recording back-to-back Top 5 finishes in Billings, Montana, and Nampa, Idaho, before closing out the regular season by finishing fourteenth in Tacoma, Washington, and sits 33.5 points behind Aparecido.

Also of note is Rookie of the Year frontrunner No. 16 Anderson de Oliveira, who was overtaken by Aparecido after missing the final two events of the season due to injury. Oliveira, who shares a chute with Tigger in the opening round, went 1-for-2 to finish 25th at the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Finals, riding Phantom for 79 points in his final out of the event in Round 2. He trails his fellow Brazilian by less than a point entering *Eliminations*.

No. 20 Kaiden Loud is also a rider to watch this week, who is just 50 points away from the Top 15. During the 2024 iteration of *Eliminations*, Loud went 3-for-4 to win the opening session, including a stage-high, 91.75-point performance aboard Doze You Down to win Round 2. The soft-spoken Texan takes on Woody in Round 1 on Thursday.

WORLD CHAMPIONS – The PBR World Champion is the bull rider who earns the most PBR Unleash The Beast points throughout the regular season and the PBR World Finals. In 2024, Cassio Dias became the second-consecutive rookie to be crowned the PBR World Champion, following in the footsteps of 2023 PBR World Champion Rafael Jose de Brito, who was the first rookie in PBR history to win a gold buckle. Dias went 41-for-76 (53%) with nine 90-point rides and entered his first PBR World Finals with a 560.5-point lead over No. 2 John Crimber. Dias continued to roll during the first two rounds of PBR World Finals *Eliminations* inside the historic Cowtown Coliseum, as he rode Sava for 86.75 points in Round 1 and Ricky Vaughn for 88 points in Round 2. However, disaster struck in Round 3 as Dias was stepped on by Norse God following his 5.78-second buckoff, leaving him immobile on the dirt. Dias was carried off on a stretcher and transported to the hospital to undergo testing. Seemingly against all odds, Dias was cleared to ride for the *Championship* stage despite spinal fracturs, broken

ribs and a partially collapsed lung. Visibly battling immense pain from his multitude of injuries, Dias bucked off Mike's Motive in 7.64 seconds in Round 1 before being dispatched in 3.05 seconds by Big Chew in Round 2. Before Dias had a chance to ride in Round 3, Crimber sat tall atop Big Bank for a monstrous 95 points, putting him into the event lead and placing Dias in a must-ride situation. With the pressure on, Dias squared off against Ricky Vaughn and converted, scoring a critical 92.5 points. After Crimber uncharacteristically bucked off in Round 4, Dias knew he had done enough to win the 2024 PBR World Championship. Despite already having won his first gold buckle, Dias rode Chiseled in Round 4 for 79.5 points, declining a reride and beginning his on-dirt celebration. Dias is the 22nd different rider – and ninth Brazilian – to claim the PBR World Championship gold buckle. His title represents the 14th time a rider from Brazil has won what's been called the most difficult individual championship in professional sports. He is also just the second PBR Brazil Champion to become a PBR World Champion. Here is a complete list of PBR World Champions:

WORLD FINALS EVENT WINNERS – The PBR World Finals event winner is the rider with the most event points after eight rounds of competition. Just eight riders have won the World Finals event and World Championship in the same season – Rafael Jose de Brito in 2023, Daylon Swearingen in 2022, Jose Vitor Leme in 2021, Jess Lockwood in 2019, Silvano Alves in 2014, J.B. Mauney in 2013, Renato Nunes in 2010 and Mike Lee in 2004. Only Robson Palermo has won the event in consecutive years (2011, 2012); he is also the only man to win the event three times (2008, 2011, and 2012). In 2024, Sage Steele Kimzey went 3-for-4 inside AT&T Stadium during the *Championship* stage to become the eighth rookie in history to win the PBR World Finals event title, joining Ronnie Kitchens (1996), Luke Snyder (2001), Jody Newberry (2003), Leme (2017), Boudreaux Campbell (2020) and Rafael Jose de Brito (2023). ROOKIES OF THE YEAR – The Rookie of the Year award is presented to the bull rider who earns the most PBR Unleash The Beast points during his first PBR season. From 2003-12, the award was presented to the bull rider who earned the most

money during his first PBR season. After Rafael Jose de Brito became the first rider to win a gold buckle and Rookie of the Year in the same season in 2023, Cassio Dias repeated the feat in 2024, putting together an even better season than Brito's already lofty mark. The reserved Brazilian got off to a red-hot start, becoming the fastest rider ever to net three career event wins, collecting those victories across the first seven events of the season. Following his third event win in Chicago, Illinois, in January, Dias overtook the No. 1 spot in the Unleash The Beast standings and held it for the remainder of the season. Across the entire campaign, Dias held the No. 1 ranking for all but two weeks of the 2024 season. Dias never rested on his laurels, winning four more events throughout the season before battling through injury and finishing seventh at his first career PBR World Finals to be crowned both the 2025 PBR World Champion and Rookie of the Year. GLEN KEELEY AWARD WINNERS – Presented to the Canadian bull rider who accumulates the most Unleash The Beast points during the premier series season, this award is named in honor of Glen Keeley, a Canadian bull rider who was fatally injured on March 24, 2000, at a PBR event in Albuquerque, New Mexico. The PBR retired No. 68 – Keeley's back number. Prior to 2013, the award was given to the Canadian bull rider who earned the most money in a season.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – Alongside the Top 45 cowboys competing for a gold buckle, the PBR's rankest bovine competitors will also be competing for the 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull honor and accompanying \$100,000 bonus. The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be the animal with the highest average bull score from his eight highest-scored outs logged during the 2024 Camping World Team Series and 2025 Unleash The Beast regular season, and their top two scores out of three outs at the 2025 PBR World Finals. The 2025 PBR World Finals will also anoint a YETI "Built for the Wild" Bull of the Finals, who will be presented with a \$25,000 bonus for posting the top combined score based on his three outs at the season-culminating event.

In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull, and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular-season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate throughout the 2025 season as he attempts to become just the seventh back-to-back World Champion Bull in PBR history, currently leading No. 2 Fast Flow by a commanding 1.94 average ride-score points. Dominant in nearly every trip, Man Hater has appeared at nine Unleash The Beast events during the regular season, earning the YETI "Built for the Wild" Bull of the Event honor during eight of those outings, with only three other animal athletes holding more than one (No. 2 Fast Flow, who has three, and No. 5 Ridin' Salty and No. 94 Slick Rick, who both have two). Only four bull scores of 48-plus points have been recorded during the 2025 title campaign, and all of them belong to Man Hater.

The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product has bucked off 11 of the 14 riders who have attempted to cover him, posting an incredible World Average of 48 points while delivering the seven-highest bull scores this season, including four being marked for 48 points or more. In his first out of the new season in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, in mid-July, Man Hater bucked off Casey Roberts in a quick 3 seconds to earn an impressive 48.75-point bull score. Later last year in Kansas City, Missouri, in September, Man Hater rocketed out of the chutes and bucked off No. 4 Sage Steele Kimzey in a blistering 2.41 seconds to deliver the top all-time score from a PBR bucking bull, marked 49.5 points.

2024 PBR World Champion Cassio Dias finally ended Man Hater's reign of terror three weeks later, despite the incredible animal athlete's 49.25-point effort, as Dias managed to make the 8 for a monstrous 98.25 points, the second-highest marked ride in PBR history and the highest ever on the PBR Camping World Team Series. The next man to ride Man Hater was No. 9 Andrew Alvidrez, as the duo posted a 94-point outing in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, in March, earning Alvidrez the 2025 Mason Lowe award for the highest-scored ride during the 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast regular season.

No. 1 Dalton Kasel was the most recent rider to cover Man Hater, riding him for 93.5 points in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, despite the bovine competitor's 45.5 points outing. Of his nine outs during the 2025 Unleash The Beast season, only one was marked less than 45 points.

ABBI CLASSIC ROUND – The first round of *Eliminations* will also feature 27 four and five-year-old bulls from the American Bucking Bull Inc. (ABBI) competing for a prize purse of \$60,000. Bovines to watch for include reigning ABBI Classic World Champion and current world No. 3 King Tut, current No. 1 in the ABBI Classic standings Yahoo, in addition to No. 3 Fast Flow, Dana White's Playmate and Slick Rick.

King Tut, who is paired with No. 12 Leonardo Castro in the opening round on Thursday, has seven outs on the top tour this season. He bucked off all but two cowboys who attempted to cover him, as he was bested by No. 22 Dener Barbosa for 89.75 points in Salt Lake City, Utah, in February and most recently by No. 15 Eduardo Aparecido for 90.5 points in Albuquerque, New Mexico, in March.

Yahoo also had seven outs during the 2025 Unleash The Beast regular season. After being ridden by No. 37 Thiago Salgado for 89.25 points in Ontario, Canada, in November, and by Barbosa for 90.25 points in Wichita, Kansas, in December, he has bucked off his next five riders. Most recently, Yahoo was marked 44.25 points after unseating No. 1 Dalton Kasel in 5.60 seconds in Little Rock, Arkansas, in March. The powerful bovine competitor duels Ashton Sahli in Round 1.

Fast Flow, who is ranked No. 2 in the 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race, is paired with No. 40 Ethan Winckler. Fast Flow is second only to Man Hater with three YETI "Built for the Wild" Bull of the Event honors during the 2025 campaign, and he has bucked off all 12 of his potential riders to post an impressive 46.06 World Average.

In four outs during the 2025 Unleash The Beast season, Dana White's Playmate has bucked off all but one cowboy, as No. 4 Sage Steele Kimzey rode him for 91 points in Salt Lake City, Utah, in February. The elite animal athlete has an exciting matchup in Round 1 on Thursday evening, as he shares a chute with two-time PBR World Champion No. 18 Jose Vitor Leme.

Finally, Slick Rick takes on veteran No. 31 João Ricardo Vieira in the opening round of *Eliminations*. He has bucked off all seven riders he has faced during the 2025 Unleash The Beast season, most recently getting the better of No. 10 Kaique Pacheco after 4.95 seconds in Tacoma, Washington, in April.

During the 2025 PBR World Finals, the ABBI will also hold the second \$1 Million Futurity on Sunday, May 11 at 9 a.m. CT at Cowtown Coliseum. This premier competition will showcase 31 of ABBI's top 2-year-old animal athletes in the richest one-day competition of the 2025 season, where the winning bull will earn \$250,000.

PROVIDING PROTECTION – This weekend's bullfighters selected to work the 2025 PBR World Finals: Unleash The Beast are Cody Webster of Wayne, Oklahoma; Lucas Teodoro of Pinhal, Brazil; Austin Ashley of Purcell, Oklahoma, and Knox Dunn of Slaughter, Louisiana. Dunn replaces Nathan Harp of Tuttle, Oklahoma, who was originally selected to work the World Finals but remains unavailable after sustaining an injury during the regular season in Little Rock, Arkansas.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – The PBR World Finals will be broken down into three stages: *Eliminations, Ride For Redemption* and *Championship*.

For *Eliminations*, the Top 40 in the Unleash The Beast standings will be joined by five riders who qualified via the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour. All 45 qualifiers will compete in four long rounds, and at the end of those four long rounds, the Top 15-ranked riders in the Unleash The Beast standings and the Top 5 cowboys in the four-round aggregate not already qualified through the standings will advance to the Championship Rounds at AT&T Stadium next week.

Those who do not meet the criteria will have a chance to redeem themselves in the *Ride For Redemption* rounds on May 14-15. One rider can earn a maximum of 556 Unleash The Beast points during *Eliminations*, netting 36 points should they score 90+ point rides in each round, 80 points for each round win, and 200 points for winning the aggregate. During *Eliminations*, more than \$690,000 will be paid out, with the top scorer daily collecting \$35,000, and the winner of the aggregate earning \$150,000.

Following the *Eliminations* stage will be the two-day *Ride For Redemption*. On Wednesday, May 14, five riders from the weekly PBR Stockyards Showcase events, the 2024 PRCA World Champion, the 2025 WRCA Rodeo Corpus Christi

Champion, ten PBR Teams invites, any of the five Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour invites to the *Eliminations* stage that fail to qualify for the *Championship* rounds and the five riders ranked 6th through 10th in the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour standings will attempt two bulls, with the five riders with the highest aggregate score advancing to the following day.

On Thursday, May 15, those five riders will join the 25 riders who didn't qualify for the *Championship* during the *Eliminations* stage. All 30 riders will attempt one bull in Round 1. The five riders who advanced via Wednesday's aggregate will only advance to Round 2 if they cover their opening round bull, while the remaining 25 riders are guaranteed to compete in both rounds. The Top 5 contestants in Thursday night's two-round *Ride For Redemption* aggregate will advance to the PBR World Finals: *Championship* at AT&T Stadium on May 17-18. While no Unleash The Beast points will be awarded during *Ride For Redemption*, the event will award \$45,000 in prize money across the four rounds of competition.

The 2025 PBR World Finals will come to a climactic end with the *Championship* event at AT&T Stadium from May 17-18, featuring the 20 advancing riders from *Eliminations* and the five competitors who punched their tickets via *Ride For Redemption*. Each day of competition will feature two rounds, with Rounds 1-2 on Saturday, May 17, followed by Rounds 3-4 on Sunday, May 18. While the 20 riders who earned a berth via *Eliminations* are guaranteed to compete in all four Championship rounds, the five contenders who advanced via *Ride For Redemption* must record a score in Round 1 or Round 2 to remain in the *Championship* for Rounds 3-4. After Round 4 at the 2025 PBR World Finals – *Championship*, the new World Champion will be the No. 1-ranked rider in the Unleash The Beast standings. The 2025 PBR World Finals event winner will be the rider with the top aggregate score across the final four rounds of action.

Inside AT&T Stadium, one rider can earn a maximum of 756 Unleash The Beast points, netting 36 points should they score 90+ point rides in each round, 80 points for each round win, and 400 points for winning the aggregate. Across those two days, the PBR will award more than \$3.26 million, including the \$1 million bonus to the 2025 PBR World Champion, \$350,000 to the World Finals event winner, and \$75,000 to each of the four Championship round winners.

TELEVISION BROADCAST – All four rounds of PBR World Finals – *Eliminations* will be available LIVE and FREE on RidePass on Pluto TV, PBR's YouTube channel (pbr.com/youtube), PBR's mobile app (https://qrco.de/bdtdKp), PBR's app on connected TVs, including Apple TV, Fire TV, Roku, and Google TV (https://qrco.de/bfYxcJ) as well as on fans' favorite web browser at watch.pbr.com. In addition, viewers can also tune into The Cowboy Channel for all four rounds of *Eliminations*. The stream for *Eliminations* begins with Round 1 on Thursday, May 8, at 8:45 p.m. ET, and continues with Round 2 on Friday, May 9, Round 3 at 8:45 p.m. ET on Saturday, May 10, and Round 4 at 2:45 p.m. ET on Sunday, May 11.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
