

2025 PBR Unleash The Beast Michelob ULTRA PBR Jacksonville VyStar Veterans Memorial Arena – Jacksonville, Florida Saturday, February 22 at 7:45 p.m. ET Sunday, February 23 at 2:45 p.m. ET

BULLS IN THE BOLD CITY – This weekend, PBR's elite 2025 Unleash The Beast returns to Jacksonville, Florida. The fourteenth stop of the 24-event 2025 individual season is the eighth time and second consecutive season the top tour has bucked into VyStar Veterans Memorial Arena. The Sunshine State will host the PBR for two days of action on Saturday, February 22, at 7:45 p.m. ET, and Sunday, February 23, at 2:45 p.m. ET.

ALVIDREZ AWESOME IN INDY TO CRACK TOP 10 – Andrew Alvidrez went 3-for-3 to win his first event of the season in Indianapolis, Indiana, last weekend, thus catapulting from No. 21 to No. 7 in the Unleash The Beast standings. After helping his Missouri Thunder beat the Kansas City Outlaws in the Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, showcase by riding The Player for 87.5 points in Round 1, the Texan hung onto American You for 80 points to earn his second trip of the season to the championship round. Alvidrez remained perfect in the championship round, topping Nobody for an event, career and season-high-tying 92.5 points to seize the lead. The veteran looks to win back-to-back premier series events for the second time in his career by taking on Tchoupitoulas in Round 1 on Saturday.

Alvidrez currently sits 249.75 points behind No. 1 Brady Fielder, who went 1-for-2 and finished tied for 21st inside Gainbridge Fieldhouse. After riding Time for Magic for 85.5 points in Round 1, the Aussie was bucked off by Ugly This in 3.85 seconds to end his weekend. Despite going just 1-for-2, Fielder holds a 105-point lead over No. 2 Dalton Kasel in the 2025 gold buckle race. Kasel, who went 2-for-3 and held the lead heading into the final round last weekend, takes on BuzzBallz in the opening round, while Fielder battles Jail Bird.

The only rider other than Alvidrez to cover all three of his bulls was No. 12 Koltin Hevalow. The Missouri native topped Whiskey Business for 85.25 points in Round 1 and Ridin' Salty for 84 points in Round 2. Locked in, Hevalow covered Doze You Down for 84.5 points in the championship round, but it wasn't enough to overtake Alvidrez. Hevalow attempts to extend his ride streak to four aboard Knight Kap in Round 1 in Jacksonville.

MONSTER ENERGY TEAM CHALLENGE – This weekend features the eighth game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the New York Mavericks face off against the Florida Freedom.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of Michelob ULTRA PBR Jacksonville features the following rematches:

- Adriano Salgado takes on Rockville once again after topping him for 91.5 points in Manchester, New Hampshire, earlier this season in December.
- Alan de Souza battles Baldy for the first time since bucking off in 1.78 seconds in Billings, Montana, last April.
- Alex Cerqueira shares a chute with I'm Legit Too for the third time after bucking off in 6.5 seconds in Guthrie, Oklahoma, in August of 2020 and in 4.24 seconds in Las Vegas, Nevada, last October.
- Eduardo Aparecido dances with Red Mosquito for the second time after bucking off in 7.84 seconds in Nashville, Tennessee, in August of 2023.
- Felipe Furlan takes on Sorrel's Pick for the third time after splitting their first two matchups. The Brazilian bucked off in 3.63 seconds in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, last July, but rebounded to make the 8 for 83.5 points the following day.
- Kaique Pacheco squares off against Bueno for the third time after covering him for 87.5 points in Las Vegas, Nevada, last October before bucking off in 3.43 seconds in Manchester, New Hampshire, later in the year in December.
- Luciano De Castro duels Bangarang once again after riding him for 87 points in Albany, New York, in December of 2023 and bucking off in 4.62 seconds in Kansas City, Missouri, in September of 2024.

PAST JACKSONVILLE EVENT WINNERS – In 2024, rookie John Crimber went 3-for-3 to win the first event of his career. The Texan rode Flatliner for 87 points to tie for third in the opening round before taking the lead heading into the championship round by covering Border Crisis for 87.75 points. In the final out of the event, Crimber walked off the win by riding Doze You Down for an event-high 91 points.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying eight Bull of the Event titles with only two other bovine competitors holding more than one (No. 2 Fast Flow, who has three, and No. 5 Ridin' Salty, who has two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 5 bull scores in the standings after being

marked 48.25 points for his buckoff of Clay Guiton in 3.10 seconds in St. Louis, Missouri, in December. After being marked 47.25 points for his buck off of Brady Fielder in New York City, the powerful bovine competitor retook the No. 1 spot in the standings, and he currently leads No. 2 Fast Flow by a considerable 1.94 points.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS *REVISED* – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will *NO LONGER* be awarded for points earned on lower level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, will award full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders took the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – Michelob ULTRA PBR Jacksonville, the fourteenth Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 44 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Saturday and all but those listed below (competing in the Monster Energy Team Challenge game) are guaranteed to get on another bull in Round 2 on Sunday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Sunday.

The following eight riders from the New York Mavericks and Florida Freedom must register qualified rides on Saturday to compete for the remainder of the weekend: Ezekiel Mitchell (NY), Marco Rizzo (NY), Mason Taylor (NY), Mauricio Moreira (NY), Alex Cerqueira (FL), Joao Lucas Campos (FL), Thiago Salgado (FL) and Yan Victor Cunha (FL).

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Fiserv Forum in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, for PBR Milwaukee. The event will be on Saturday, March 1, at 7:45 p.m. CT, and Sunday, March 2, at 1:45 p.m. CT.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
