TACOMA TWO-STEP – This weekend, PBR’s elite 2025 Unleash The Beast returns to Tacoma, Washington. The 23rd stop of the 24-event individual season is the fourth consecutive season and 16th time the top tour has visited Tacoma. The Tacoma Dome will host the PBR for two days of action on Saturday, April 26, at 6:45 p.m. PT and Sunday, April 27, at 1:45 p.m. PT.

KASEL WINS FIFTH EVENT OF 2025, LEADS FIELDER BY 187 POINTS – No. 1 Dalton Kasel continued to roll in Nampa, Idaho, last weekend, winning his tour-best fifth event of the season. The Texan covered Whip for 87 points in Round 1 before riding Peanut for an event-high-tying 89.25 points to win Round 2. In the championship round, Kasel sat tall atop Manaba for 88.5 points to not only win his 14th round of the season but also increase his lead over No. 2 Brady Fielder to 187 points heading into the final event of the regular season. Kasel faces off with Devine Dan in Round 1 on Saturday.

Also of note was the performance of two-time PBR World Champion and No. 19 Jose Vitor Leme, who went 3-for-3 and finished second. The Brazilian rode Buckaroo for 87 points in Round 1 and Rank Hank for 88.25 points in Round 2. Taking advantage of a re-ride opportunity in the championship round, Leme roared out of the chutes on Lights Out in the final out of the event for 88.25 points to take the second spot on the podium. Leme’s flawless weekend propelled him from No. 27 to No. 19 in the Unleash The Beast standings, 848.5 points behind No. 1 Kasel. Leme takes on Whiskey Business in the opening round this weekend.

MONSTER ENERGY TEAM CHALLENGE – This weekend features the fifteenth game of the 2025 Monster Energy Team Challenge, presented by Camping World, as the Florida Freedom battle the New York Mavericks.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the PBR Tacoma features the following rematches:

- Boudreaux Campbell battles Buckaroo for the first time since bucking off in 3.33 seconds in Sunrise, Florida, in August of 2024.
- Cort McFadden attempts to get out of the gate aboard The Colonel after the pair were unable to do so in Louisville, Kentucky, in April of 2024.
- Daylon Swearingen faces off with Beef Cake for the second time after being bested in 2.59 seconds in Billings, Montana, earlier in April.
- Dener Barbosa shares a chute with Johnny Rocket for the first time since he rode him for 86.5 points in Memphis, Tennessee, in February of 2024.
- Leonardo Castro made the 8 for 87 points aboard Buckshot in the duo's first matchup in Sacramento, California, in January of 2025.

PAST TACOMA EVENT WINNERS – Last season in Tacoma, Washington, Alan de Souza went 3-for-3 to take home the event title. After riding Fort Knox for 81.5 points in Round 1, the Brazilian covered Hell Bound for 80.75 points in Round 2. Now in a groove, Souza made the 8 aboard Centerfold for 84.75 points in the championship round to complete his perfect weekend and win the event.

While Souza was the only rider to cover all three of his bulls in Tacoma, Sage Steele Kimzey also had a notable performance. After bucking off The Judge in 6.50 seconds in Round 1, Kimzey rallied back to split the round win in the second round by covering Tijuana Two-Step for 88 points before winning the championship round with an event-high 91.5-point outing on UTZ BesTex Legend.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2025 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2025 Unleash The Beast season. The 2025 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular seasons and top two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For the avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular-season out, the score at the World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular-season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull Man Hater has continued to dominate during the 2025 season, tallying twelve Bull of the Event titles with only three other bovine competitors holding more than one (No. 2 Fast Flow, who has three, and No. 5 Ridin’ Salty and Slick Rick, who both have two). The Jane Clark and Gene Owen product also holds the Top 7 bull scores in the standings after being marked 47 points for his buckoff of Clay Guiton in 3.88 seconds in Louisville, Kentucky, in March. After being marked 47.25 points for his buckoff of Brady Fielder in New York City, the powerful bovine competitor retook the No. 1 spot in the standings, and he currently leads No. 2 Fast Flow by a considerable 1.94 points.

2025 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS *REVISED* – The 2025 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season keeps the same elite tour point structure as 2024 but removes PBR Majors. The 2025 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2025 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events. On December 12, 2024, the points system was retroactively revised so that a quarter (1/4) Unleash The Beast point will **NO LONGER** be awarded for points earned on lower-level tours, and all Unleash The Beast points earned from non-premier series events would be removed. However, the Velocity Tour event held in conjunction with the Denver Stock Show and Rodeo on January 13-15, 2025, and the Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth, Texas, on January 21, 2025, awarded full UTB points for every Velocity Global point earned at those events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut took place after the fourth UTB event in Wichita, Kansas, on Dec. 13-14. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders took the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 20-21. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points, and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – PBR Tacoma, the twenty-third Unleash The Beast event of the 2025 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 44 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Saturday, and all but the rider listed below are guaranteed to get on another bull in Round 2 on Sunday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Sunday.

The Florida Freedom's Yan Victor Cunha must ride on Saturday to advance to Round 2 on Sunday.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
